APPROVAL—CONTRACT BY THE STATE OF OHIO ON BEHALF OF MIAMI UNIVERSITY, OXFORD, OHIO, AND THE PAUL SCHUTTE FURNITURE COMPANY OF CINCINNATI, OHIO, FOR FURNISHING DRAPES, LAMPS, ETC.
