Narrative:

On Monday, December 15, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Joe Lamping (SA Lamping) received a "Firearms Trace Summary" report from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF). The report contained information about the firearm that John Adams (Adams) possessed during the incident on November 14, 2025. The report provided details about the Glock, model 43X, serial number AKSC987, including that it [REDACTED]

Additionally, an FBI National Crime Information Center (NCIC) check of the weapon was conducted by the BCI Criminal Intelligence Unit to determine if the weapon was reported as being stolen. According to the report, [REDACTED].
