On Wednesday, March 26, 2025, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Aja Chung (SA Chung) received an email from the Ross County Coroner's Office providing the results of Daniel Wayne Long's (Long) autopsy. The autopsy was performed at the Montgomery County Coroner's Office (MCCO) in Dayton, Ohio on February 18, 2025.

The following is a summary of the information SA Chung received from the MCCO and Ross County Coroner's Office and is deemed to be of the most relevant. The author is not a doctor, it is suggested that the report be viewed in its entirety to ensure no pertinent information has been omitted or described out of context. Dr. Higgs stated the following in his autopsy report:



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
