Narrative:

On September 21, 2023, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Identification and Investigation (BCI) Special Agent Ryan Scheiderer (SA Scheiderer) obtained two search warrants for AT&T to obtain records for telephone numbers 614–264–1442 and 740–367–3660. Those numbers were found within a partial extraction of the cellular telephone thought to belong to Ta'Kiya Young (Young). Both search warrants were signed by Franklin County Court of Common Please Judge Andria Noble and filed under seal with the Clerk of Courts Office. SA Joseph Wilhelm of the BCI Cyber Crimes Unit submitted both warrants to AT&T.

On September 27, 2023, agents received a response from AT&T that the requested records were available. AT&T didn't have any records for 740-367-3660 (found to be incorrect telephone number listed on search warrant). AT&T provided several records for 614-264-1442, which are attached to this report and available for review. The following is a summation of what was observed within those records:

- Account Number: 406785359
- Active: 8/30/2008 Current
- IMEI: 353665907217387 (Doesn't match IMEI extracted from Young's phone)

No evidence either telephone number was used by Young during the time of the fatal shooting incident.

Summary:

On 09/07/2023, the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation's (BCI) Cyber Crimes Unit (CCU) was requested by the Blendon Township Police Department and the BCI Special Investigations Unit to assist in the investigation of subject TA'KIYA YOUNG, pursuant to a search warrant, for the alleged commission of the criminal offense(s) of 2913.02 Theft, 2911.02 Robbery, 2903.11 Felonious assault.

Submitted Items:

001 CCU#; Evidence #4, Scene #1 - Mobile Phone - Gray Apple iPhone 12 Pro Max A2342

Details:

The cell phone was submitted powered off with the SIM card inserted. The SIM card was removed from the cell phone, placed in an adapter, and connected to a forensic computer. Cellebrite was used to perform a data extraction of the SIM card and then it was placed back in the cell phone. The cell phone was powered on in a Faraday box to prevent communication on the cellular network and discovered to have an unknown 6 digit passcode. The phone was already in Airplane mode. The phone was connected to GrayKey, but only a partial extraction could be performed on the locked device. The extractions were processed with Cellebrite.

Findings:

The cell phone is running the iOS operating system version 16.6. The phone has the serial number G0NF936S0D43 and the International Mobile Equipment Identity (IMEI) 353730397528782 and 353730397548293. The AT&T SIM has the Integrated Circuit Card Identifier (ICCID) 89012804320026191147, International Mobile Subscriber Identity (IMSI) 310280002619114, and Mobile Station International Subscriber Directory Number (MSISDN) 16142641442. The cell phone has an additional ICCID 89012807330986250244, IMSI 310280098637029, and MSISDN The name of the phone is "iPhone." The cell phone has no recorded iCloud backup date. The owner name is "Kiya Young" and the Apple ID is kiyayoung1@gmail.com. The Gmail account is takiyayoung18@gmail.com. The TextMe username is "bvj54tqwvq0973" and email bvj54tqwvq@privaterelay.appleid.com. The TextNow

Conclusions:

The cell phone is locked with an unknown 6 digit passcode so only partial data could be extracted. The phone is not supported at this time to determine the passcode.

Double-click "CellebriteReader.exe" to open the application. Allow a few seconds for the data to begin loading indicated by a green status bar in the bottom right corner. If the parsed data is not loaded automatically then click Open from the File menu, browse to this folder, and choose "Apple iPhone 12 Pro Max A2342 Report.ufdr" to view the partial data that was processed from the cell phone.

<u>NOTE:</u> In Cellebrite Reader, some entries may be hidden based on the program's default behavior. Go to Tools -> Settings -> General Settings -> "Duplicate Rules" and choose either "Show group of similar items" or "Show all items." Also go to Tools -> Settings -> Timeline and select all of the data you want to show in the Timeline view.
