**Narrative:**

On Tuesday, June 28, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Criminal Intelligence Analyst Lori Braunschweiger contacted the Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) and requested a Firearms Trace of the weapon that Quincy Pritchett (Pritchett) was found to be in possession of as the result of the Officer Involved Critical Incident in Lima, Ohio on June 21, 2022. During the processing of the scene, investigators recovered a Taurus, Model #G-3, 9 millimeter (mm), semi-automatic pistol bearing Serial Number AAL011565. Criminal Intelligence Analyst Braunschweiger documented this information on the ATF e-Trace form which was later forwarded to the ATF.

On Wednesday, June 29, 2022, Criminal Intelligence Analyst Braunschweiger received a copy of the ATF e-Trace concerning the aforementioned firearm. BCI Special Agent Supervisor (SAS) Scott Stranahan reviewed the ATF e-Trace report and learned the following information.

Investigators then queried Snipes' Ohio Driver's license number through the Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles Database. [REDACTED]

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Upon learning this information, Special Agent (SA) Tiffany Vollmer contacted the Lima Police Department and requested that they check their records/reports database for any reports possibly filed by Snipes in which he reported the aforementioned firearm stolen. A short time later, SA Vollmer received a copy of a Lima Police Department report filed by Snipes where he reported the firearm being stolen. SAS Stranahan then reviewed the Lima Police Department report and learned the following information.

The report was date and time stamped as June 21, 2022 at approximately 1523 hours (3:23 p.m.). The victim/complainant was listed as Snipes. At the time of the report, Snipes reported his address as 760 East 4th Street, Apartment B4, Lima, Ohio 45804. Snipes also listed his telephone number as 419-989-9655. The reporting officer was listed as Samuel Kerber, Badge # 9115.

In summary, Snipes contacted the Lima Police Department via telephone to make a report concerning a stolen firearm. Snipes reported that on June 20, 2022, between the hours of 0300 and 1400 hours (3:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.), unknown individual(s) entered his apartment and took his firearm without permission. According to Snipes the firearm was stored in a shoebox in his closet and he was the only individual who knew the location of the firearm.

According to Snipes, the firearm was loaded and contained approximately 10 rounds of ammunition. Snipes described the firearm as being a black, Taurus, G3, semi-automatic pistol with serial number AAL011565. Snipes reported that he delayed making the report so he had the opportunity to check his apartment to ensure he did not misplace the firearm in another location. According to Snipes, he purchased the firearm from American Pawn in Lima, Ohio. Snipes said that he does not have the sales receipt, but that he would attempt to obtain it from the point of purchase. Snipes also said that he has two room mates and he does not suspect they are involved in the theft of his firearm. No additional information was contained within the Lima Police Department report. A copy of the referenced Lima Police Department report has been attached to this investigative report and has also been placed into this case file.

**NARRATIVE**

On 06/21/2022, Caiden Snipes called the Lima PD front desk to report a stolen firearm. He advised sometime between 06/20/2022 0300-1400, someone stole his Black Taurus G3 semi automatic pistol (AAL011565) from his apartment. The firearm was in a shoe box in his closet, and he was the only one who knew it was there. There was a 15 round magazine with 10 rounds loaded with the firearm. There was not a round in the chamber. Caiden looked in the shoe box and found the firearm missing. He waited to report it because he wanted to look around his apartment to see if he misplaced it.

Caiden bought the firearm from American Pawn. He does not remember where the receipt is for proof of purchase, but would try to get a copy from the store. He does not know who stole the firearm from his apartment. Caiden advised his friend, Jason Sturgeon, and his girlfriend Shaquila Schodowski live with him. He advised they did not steal his firearm.
