Narrative:

On Tuesday, February 24, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Douglas Burke (Burke) received the Crime Scene Log (CSL) in reference to the Officer-Involved Critical Incident (OICI) which had taken place in the area of 10810 Brookpark Rd., Brooklyn, OH 44130. The (CSL) had been documented by an officer from the Parma Police Department (PPD).

On the same date, SA Burke received a copy of the Search Warrant and the Search Warrant Affidavit from Detective (Det.) Brad Washburn (Washburn) of the Brooklyn Police Department (BPD) for the vehicle of the involved subject, Ricardo Yuuki Davis (Ricardo). The Search Warrant was for a 2015, red four (4) door Toyota Corolla, with Ohio Registration JSF 3645, and had been granted and signed by a judge from Parma Municipal Court for BCI's Crime Scene Unit (CSU) to process the vehicle which belonged to Ricardo, along with the scene on the roadway of 10810 Brookpark Rd., Brooklyn, OH 44130.

WHEREAS: Affiant has exhibited probable cause necessary to search the below listed property, wherein Affiant avers that he has reasonable cause to believe, and does believe, that in vehicle known as: 2015 Toyota Corolla, red in color having a VIN of 5YFBURHE5FP301900 and currently bearing Ohio Reg. JSF3645 that is currently being held at the scene of a Police involved shooting, on Brookpark Road westbound adjacent to IHOP, 10810 Brookpark Road, City of Brooklyn, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, there is now being kept, concealed, and possessed the following evidence of a criminal offense:

Any and all evidence of an offense involving the discharge of a firearm and associated actions, which may contain evidence pertaining to this crime including the firearm, ammunition, bullet casings any and all other contraband and all evidence pertaining to the violations of the laws of the State of Ohio, to wit: Chapter 2923 and any other sections of the Ohio Revised Code.

I am satisfied that there is probable cause to believe that the evidence described is being concealed in the above-described vehicle, and that grounds for issuance of this search warrant exist.

THEREFORE: You are hereby commanded in the name of the State of Ohio, with the necessary and proper assistance, to serve this warrant and search forthwith with the necessary assistance for the property specified by extracting the information with any qualified and necessary assistance, and that once extracted, that Affiant and/or other investigating officers/agents are authorized to search said vehicle for the above-described information. If any

of the above-described property or any part thereof be found there, you are commanded to seize it, leaving a copy of this warrant and a receipt for the property taken, to prepare a written inventory of the property seized, to return this warrant to the undersigned or any Judge of the Parma Municipal Court, and to bring the property found on such search forthwith before said Judge, or some other judge or magistrate of the county having cognizance thereof.

AFFIDAVIT FOR SEARCH WARRANT

Before me, a Judge of the Parma Municipal Court, Cuyahoga County, Ohio, personally appeared the undersigned Detective Brad Washburn #55, who, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that he is a member in good standing of the Brooklyn Police Department, and that his training and experience include the following: Over fourteen (14) years of experience as a police officer, of which the last thirteen (13) years has been with the Brooklyn Police Department. The affiant is currently assigned to the Detective Bureau and has been for the last year. Det. Washburn received his basic law enforcement training at the Tri-C Academy and has experience in the investigation of felony offenses including weapons offenses. Affiant states that in his current and past assignments he has participated in numerous investigations and search warrants resulting in arrests and prosecutions for violations of State Laws.

WHEREAS: Affiant has exhibited probable cause necessary to search the below listed property, wherein Affiant avers that he has reasonable cause to believe, and does believe, that in vehicle known as: 2015 Toyota Corolla, red in color having a VIN of 5YFBURHE5FP301900 and currently bearing Ohio Reg. JSF3645 that is currently in the possession of the Brooklyn Police Department, 8000 Memphis Ave, City of Brooklyn, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, there is now being kept, concealed, and possessed the following evidence of a criminal offense:

Any and all evidence of an offense involving the discharge of a firearm and associated actions, which may contain evidence pertaining to this crime including the firearm, ammunition, bullet casings any and all other contraband and all evidence pertaining to the violations of the laws of the State of Ohio, to wit: Chapter 2923 and any other sections of the Ohio Revised Code.

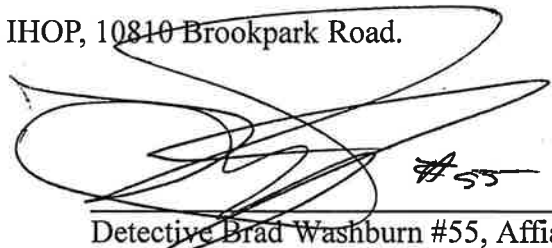
The facts upon which Affiant bases such belief are as follows:

1. Affiant avers that on February 24, 2026 Parma Police Officers were dispatched to a welfare check at 5433 Knollwood Drive #8 in Parma, Ohio for a suicidal male named Ricardo Yuuki Davis.
2. The affiant avers that the Parma Police Department was advised by Henry Sieaaniec that his friend, Ricardo Davis, was suicidal. Davis called Sieaaniec and said, "Good Bye".
3. The affiant avers that the Parma Police Department responded to 5433 Knollwood Drive #8 to check on Davis' welfare.
4. The affiant avers that the Parma Police Department received knowledge that Davis has previously attempted suicide.
5. The affiant avers that the Parma Police Department gained entry into Davis' apartment. Once inside, they observed multiple notes inside of the apartment where items were labeled to go to certain members of Davis' family. Davis also left information about a death certificate.
6. The affiant avers that the Parma Police Department found receipts inside of Davis' apartment for a Taurus handgun purchased at Parma Armory, 5301 Hauserman Road in Parma, Ohio.
7. The affiant avers that Parma PD located Davis near the intersection of Brookpark Road and Hauserman Road.
8. The affiant avers that Davis began driving away from Parma Officers in his red 2015 Toyota Corolla bearing Ohio license plate JSF3645.
9. The affiant avers that as Davis was driving away from Parma Police Officers, he reached into his back seat for what appeared to be a gun.
10. The affiant avers Davis stopped his Toyota on Brookpark Road westbound in front of IHOP, 10810 Brookpark Road.
11. The affiant avers that Davis got out of his Toyota and walked rapidly towards Parma PD cruisers.

12. The affiant avers that several gunshots were fired and Davis was allegedly struck by at least one bullet. A Parma Police cruiser was struck by another bullet.
13. The affiant avers that Parma Police Officers performed CPR on Davis after gunshots were fired.
14. The affiant avers that Davis was transported to Metro Hospital, 2500 Metrohealth Drive, in Cleveland, where he was later pronounced deceased.

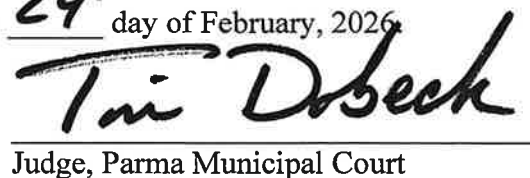
