SUMMARY:

On Monday, February 9, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Lurna McClintock and Crime Scene Technician (CST) Michael Rostocil examined the clothing collected from the crime scene. The clothing was photographed and additional evidence was collected.

Narrative:

On Monday, February 9, 2026, at approximately 1046 hours, CST Rostocil received the following items from Administrative Professional Betsy Turney, who retrieved them from Evidence Storage:

- Blue T-shirt (crime scene Item #14)
- Jeans (crime scene Item #20)
- Jacket (crime scene Item #23)
- Underwear (crime scene Item #25)
- Gray jacket (crime scene Item #26)

All of the above items were photographed and examined for ballistic impacts. The jeans were examined first, and several suspected ballistic impacts were located and documented. The ballistic impacts were labeled as BI for documentation purposes. The jeans were found to be "REFINERY REPUBLIC" brand, size 36x30 with a black braided belt. The jeans were found to contain the following items, which were photographed and collected separately:

- A black holster, located attached to the left inside of the belt/jeans
- A black/pink Eiffel Tower pillowcase, from the left rear pocket
- \$21.33 from the left rear pocket and both front pockets
- A purple lighter and 2 ChapSticks from the front pockets

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The back side of the jeans exhibited several suspected ballistic impacts (Figure #1). Ballistic impacts were found in the upper right waist area (BI 1.0), just below that in the right rear pocket (BI 2.0), in the middle buttocks area (BI 3.0), the left middle leg (BI 4.0), and the right ankle area (BI 5.0).

The jacket (Item #23) was examined next. The jacket was found to be a Columbia brand jacket, size M, which was in 3 pieces. A baby bib was also with it; most likely inadvertently collected from the scene with the clothing. The left side of the jacket was photographed and examined with no significant findings. The right side of the jacket exhibited several suspected ballistic impacts (Figures #2-3). A ballistic impact was located in the lower right side next to the front pocket (BI 6.0), in the back side middle back area (BI 7.0), and several impacts in a linear orientation up near the back side neck area (BI 8.0).

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A gray and blue jacket (Item #26) was examined next. The jacket was found to be the right half, Arizona Jean Company brand, size Large. The jacket exhibited suspected ballistic impacts (Figure #4). A ballistic impact was located in the lower right side, which was labeled as BI 6.1, consistent in location with BI 6.0 from the previous jacket. A second ballistic impact was located in the middle back area, which was labeled BI 7.1, consistent in location with BI 7.0 from the previous jacket.

The blue T-shirt (Item #14) was examined next. The T-shirt was found to be an ADIDAS brand shirt, cut up in the middle. The shirt exhibited several suspected ballistic impacts (Figures #5-6). A ballistic impact was located in the lower right side, which was labeled as BI 6.2, consistent in location with BI 6.0 and BI 6.1 from the previous jackets. A ballistic impact was located in right middle back side of the shirt, which was labeled as BI 7.2, consistent in location with BI 7.0 and BI 7.1 from the previous jackets. Several ballistic impacts in a linear orientation were located up near the back side neck area, which were labeled as BI 8.1, consistent in location with BI 8.0 from the Columbia jacket.

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The underwear (Item #25) was examined next. The underwear was found to be blue HANES brand, with suspected bloodstains on the back side. The underwear exhibited several suspected ballistic impacts (Figure #7). A ballistic impact was located in the upper right back side near the waistband, which was labeled as BI 1.1, consistent in location with BI 1.0 in the jeans. Two ballistic impacts were located below that on the back side of the right side, labeled BI 9.0 and BI 10.0. These were both consistent in location with BI 2.0 in the right back side of the jeans but could not be distinguished. It should also be noted that a second ballistic impact in this area was not located in the jeans, potentially due to the fact it was cut through during medical intervention. A ballistic impact and some possible smaller associated defects were located in the lower middle portion, which were labeled as BI 11.0. This was consistent in location with BI 3.0 in the back side middle of the jeans.

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The clothing and additional items of evidence were re-packaged and given to Administrative Professional Betsy Turney to return to Evidence Storage and approximately 1240 hours.
