APPROVAL — LEASE OF RESERVOIR LAND AT RUSSEL'S POINT, LOGAN COUNTY, OHIO, TO CHARLES E. WRIGHT OF SYDNEY, OHIO.

DEAR SIR: I am in receipt of a communication from the Chief of the Bureau of Inland Lakes and Parks of the Division of Conservation in your department, requesting my approval of a certain reservoir land lease in triplicate, executed by the Conservation Commissioner to one Charles E. Wright of Sidney, Ohio.

By this lease, which is one for a term of fifteen years and which provides for an annual rental of \$36.00, there is leased and demised to the lessee above named, the right to occupy and use for cottage site purposes only, the State property known as Lot No. 2, Tract No. 2 of the Peter Schlegel allotment of Russels Point, Ohio, being part of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 36, Town 6 South, Range 8 East, Washington Township, Logan County, Ohio, and being a renewal of a part of the lease granted to Peter Schlagel under date of August 8, 1921.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by the Conservation Commissioner and by said lessee. I further find, upon consideration of the provisions of this lease and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with Section 471, General Code, under the authority of which this lease is executed, and with other statutory enactments relating to leases of this kind.

I am accordingly approving this lease as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the lease and upon the duplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith returned.
