Narrative:

On May 20, 2025, several officers with the Columbus Division of Police (CPD) responded to 4482 Hampton Woods Court, Columbus, Ohio, to a shooting complaint which ultimately resulted in an Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI).

As a part of the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation's (BCI) investigation into the above incident, CPD provided BCI with a large volume of body worn camera (BWC) footage associated with officers responding to the incident. BCI Special Agent Craig Call (SA Call) was assigned to review a portion of the reference video footage. SA Call was assigned to review 22 videos uploaded by 11 officers who responded to the incident. The above officers all appeared to serve in the large initial response to the scene and later assumed perimeter security posts at various positions before being relieved. Several of the above videos contain information long after or long before the OICI.

Due to the nature of the above officers' level of involvement in the OICI, a visual review only of the individual videos was conducted.
