Narrative:

On Tuesday, December 22, 2020, at 0815 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation Special Agent Richard Ward met with George Skulski who resides at 1057 Oberlin Drive, which is the south side of the roadway, across from 1054 Oberlin Drive (location of 911 caller).

Skulski stated on this day at approximately 0115 hours, he took his dog for a walk and observed a white or silver SUV idling on the northside of the road in front of 1054 Oberlin Drive. Skulski stated he also observed "Bill's" garage door open.

Skulski stated he does not have any recording equipment/cameras at his residence and did not contact the police regarding the SUV. Skulski walked outside and Agent Ward pointed at the silver Chevrolet Tahoe and asked Skulski if this was the SUV he was referencing to and Skulski stated it may be the vehicle. Skulski had no additional information reference 1062 Oberlin Drive and the interview was concluded.
