## **Summary:**

On Monday, April 1, 2024, BCI Special Agents Larry Hootman, Chad Doran, and Crime Scene Technician Michael Rostocil assisted the Tuscarawas County Sheriff's Department with the processing of an outdoor crime scene located at multiple locations off E High Avenue in New Philadelphia, OH regarding an officer-involved critical incident. On Monday, April 1, 2024, SA Doran and CST Rostocil attended the autopsy of Matthew Flynn which was conducted at the Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner's Office (11001 Cedar Avenue, Cleveland, OH 44106).

## **Details:**

On Monday, April 1, 2024, at 0900 hours, CST Rostocil contacted the Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner's Office and spoke with the Investigations Unit regarding the autopsy of Matthew Flynn. CST Rostocil learned that the autopsy was already in progress.

At approximately 1000 hours, CST Rostocil and SA Doran arrived at the Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner's Office and attended the autopsy of Matthew Flynn, which was conducted by Dr. Daniel Sullivan.

SA Doran and CST Rostocil completed the observation of the autopsy at approximately 1106 hours and cleared from the Cuyahoga County Medical Examiner's Office.

This report is meant to be a general summary of the autopsy and is not to be used as a substitute for the complete autopsy report completed by Dr. Sullivan.
