On May 30th, 2022 at approximately 0300 hours, I, Ptlm. Westfield #554, was radio dispatched to 15310 Fernway Dr. for a report of approximately 17 shots being fired.

Upon our arrival, Ptlm. Lowe #563, and I made contact with, Demarco Henderson, who was parked on the street in front of 15304 Fernway Dr in his 2019 white Nissan bearing Ohio License Plate #JIR8558 VIN: 1N4BL4BV1KC230685 at the time of the shooting. Demarco stated he was sitting in his vehicle with his friend, Jordanne Jones. Demarco stated a gray Ford Focus unknown license plate pulled up and began shooting at the residence of 15310 Fernway Dr. According to Demarco, the shots came from the rear driver seat window. Demarco stated the Ford fled westbound towards Dunham Rd.

Ptlm. Lowe, spoke with the resident of 15304 Fernway Dr., Chara Thompson, who advised she was inside her residence with her daughter, Charla Williams, when her residence was struck numerous times by gunfire. See Ptlm. Lowe's initial report for more information.

REF: MA-22-10109615. At approximately 0410 hours, we cleared Fernway Dr. and Ptlm. Lowe responded to the Maple Heights Police Department to begin paperwork. OIC, Frazier and I, responded to the Service Garage for fuel and to check a special attention. At approximately 0414 hours, I heard one shot being fired coming from the area of Fernway Dr. I broadcasted information to available units. OIC, Frazier and I, responded back to Fernway Dr. and were flagged down by residents. Residents advised the same vehicle (Gray Ford) returned and fired a shot than fled towards Dunham Rd. Moments later, Ptlm. Mijangos #551, broadcasted that he had eyes on a gray Ford and that the Ford was speeding northbound on Broadway Ave. Ptlm. Mijangos advised the vehicle was not stopping to his emergency signals. See Ptlm. Mijangos pursuit report and supplement for further detail.

Ptlm. Mijangos advised the Ford crashed on Buckeye Rd near McCurdy Ave and three subject males fled the vehicle. While OIC Frazier, and I, were attempting to catch up to the pursuit. Cdt. Duncan broadcasted that three males ran from the vehicle. Shortly afterwards, Cdt. Duncan advised via radio one subject male was shot. OIC Frazier and I, arrived on the scene of the last known location provided by Ptl. Mijangos. As I exited my marked police unit #4402, Cdt. Duncan yelled "over here". Officers ran to Cdt. Duncan's location.

I observed Cdt. Duncan standing behind a tree in front of 2747 McCurdy Ave. just at the corner of the driveway. I observed the subject male lying in the front yard of 2747 McCurdy Ave. The residence was fenced in. I drew my service weapon and gave verbal commands, "show your hands". The subject male was not moving. I jumped over the fence and slowly approached the subject. The subject was bleeding excessively from his lower torso. Cdt. Duncan and I placed the subject in handcuffs. Cleveland PD responded and began CPR on the subject. Cleveland EMS arrived and transported the subject to the University Hospital Main Campus located at 11100 Euclid Ave. I followed behind Cleveland EMS Squad.

Upon arrival, UH pronounced the male deceased at 0454 by MD. Mcfarland.

On May 30, 2022, at approximately 0300 hours, I, Ptl. M. Lowe #563, along with other Maple Heights Police units responded to 15310 Fernway Dr. for a report of shots fired.

Upon my arrival, I spoke with the resident, later identified as Chara Thompson. Chara stated she was in her bedroom sleeping. Chara stated at approximately 0300 hours she was awakened by multiple gun shots striking her home. Chara stated after hearing the shots she ran upstairs to check on her child, later identified as Charla Williams. Chara reported that herself and Charla were not injured by the gun shots that entered her home. Chara stated she believed that the previous tenant, Shatwoyne Cummings, was possibly involved. Maple Heights Police units located a total of 22 bullet marks in the home. I observed a vehicle, a blue 2008 Chevrolet Cobalt, (RP: HYK3015 VIN: 1G1AL58F387234047) that was parked in the driveway. The vehicle's back windshield was completely shattered by a gunshot.

I then spoke with the caller, Natreasha Edwards, who resides at Natreasha stated around 0250 hours she and her children were awakened by the sounds of multiple gunshots. Natreasha stated she and were asleep in her bedroom. Natreasha's 14Y/O, NEE was asleep in the her son, 10Y/O N living room on the couch. Natreasha stated a bullet went through the west side of the home and struck the wall was sleeping. Natreasha stated after the bullet struck her home, she and her children laid on the floor for safety. At that time Natreasha called 911 for assistance.

I then spoke with Demarco Henderson, who witnessed the incident occur. Demarco stated he parked his vehicle in front of 15310 Fernway Dr. to pick up his girlfriend, Jordanne Jones. Demarco stated he observed a gray Ford Focus (unknown registration) traveling west bound on Fernway Dr. with the headlights off. Demarco stated the vehicle stopped momentarily, and Demarco heard multiple gunshots coming from the vehicle, as well as muzzle flashes from the backseat. At that time, Demarco stated he ducked his head under the steering wheel to avoid being struck by gunfire. Demarco stated he then exited his vehicle to check for bullet marks, but none were found. Demarco did not report any injuries. Demarco had 4 bullet marks in the passenger side of his vehicle, which he stated were from a prior incident that occurred in Cleveland.

Maple Heights Police units canvassed the area of the home to attempt to locate shell casings. I located one 9mm Luger round in the street in front of 15312 Fernway Dr. Photographs of the shell casing were taken. I collected the shell casing and placed it into an evidence envelope. Photographs of the bullet holes to the residence of 15312 Fernway Dr. were taken. Officers cleared from the call at approximately 0410 hours.

At approximately 0414 hours Ptl. Frazier and Ptl. Westfield were at the service garage, located at 5501 Dunham Road, when they heard one gunshot coming from the area of Fernway Dr. While Maple Heights Police units were enroute to Fernway Dr. the suspect vehicle a, gray Ford Focus, which witnesses described as being involved in the first incident was observed by Ptl. M. Mijangos and Cdt. Duncan traveling northwest on old Granger Rd. at a high rate of speed. A caller from the second incident also stated that a gray Ford shot at least one round and fled the scene. Ptl. M. Mijangos and Cdt. Duncan pursued the Ford into Cleveland. (For more details see Ptl. M. Mijangos supplement.)

Maple Heights Police units advised over the radio that the suspect crashed the Ford on Buckeye Road at Mc Curdy Ave. (Cleveland, Ohio) and then fled on foot. While I was enroute Cdt. T. Duncan advised over the radio that shots had been fired. Once I arrived to the scene I exited my patrol vehicle (4428) and ran southbound on Mc Curdy to assist other Maple Heights Police units at 2747 McCurday Ave. I observed a

A female stated she was stopped in her vehicle when she observed a gray or silver Ford Focus drive over the curb on the North side of the road. I approached the residence of 15310 Fernway and instructed asked Ptl. Lowe to show me where the bullet strikes were to the residence. The female resident, Chara Thompson, stated her house was struck with bullets on May 7, 2022, reference incident number 22-10091075. Chara pointed out the bullet strikes from today's incident. I marked the bullet strikes with the date and numbered each bullet strike that Chara identified. I then asked Chara which bullet strikes were from May 7, 2022, once again she pointed out the bullet strikes from May 7th, I marked the date "5/7" on each bullet hole.

Ptl. Lowe photographed the scene and collected the single casing which lied in the roadway near 15310 Fernway Drive; see Ptl. Lowe's supplement for further.

Ptl. Westfield and I cleared the scene and drove to the Maple Heights Service Department to get gas for my marked Maple Heights Police cruiser # 4401, located at 5501 Dunham Road, just North of Fernway Drive. At approximately 0414 hours, while at the Service Department, Ptl. Westfield asked me if I heard a gunshot and I told him "no". I asked Ptl. Westfield how many gunshots he heard and which direction he heard it from and he replied "Fernway". Ptl. Westfield updated other Maple Heights Units; reference incident number 22-101 09615. I began driving South on Dunham Road from the Service Department and I observed a silver vehicle at a distance ahead travelling at a speed that I approximately to be 45 mph. I initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle, and discovered the vehicle to be a silver Chevrolet Cobalt, bearing OH registration # HYK3015; that vehicle was found not to be involved. I informed the responding units to check the area of Granger Road, Libby Road and Broadway Avenue. Ptl. Mijangos asked for the suspect's vehicle description and I advised him the vehicle was believed to be a silver Ford Focus, according to witness testimony. Ptl. Mijangos advised he observed a Ford Fusion travelling East on Granger Road at a high rate of speed. Ptl. Mijangos advised the vehicle was not stopping for his emergency signals and a pursuit ensued.

McCurdy Street. I arrived to the last known location of Ptl. Mijangos and Ptl. Duncan. Upon arrival, I observed a person standing on the sidewalk on McCurdy Street, as I exited my vehicle I could hear Ptl. Duncan's voice coming from the direction of McCurdy Street.

Ptl. Westfield and I ran to Ptl. Duncan's location, where I observed a medium complexioned male with dread locs lying in a grassy area behind the chain linked fence of 2747 McCurdy Street. The fence had a rusted chain, looped around the closing of the fence, which kept the gate closed. The male was lying on his stomach and was slightly moving. We gave the male several commands to show Officers his hands, however he was not responding to our commands. Ptl. Duncan informed me that he did observe a firearm in the male's possession. A short time later, the male was no longer moving. Ptl. Westfield jumped the fence and Ptl. Duncan followed behind Ptl. Westfield and jumped the fence as well while I provided lethal coverage. At this time Ptl. Westfield and Ptl. Duncan placed the male in handcuffs. Cleveland Police arrived on scene and I noticed Ptl. Mijangos was not in the area. I made several attempts to located Ptl. Mijangos without success. Ptl. Mijangos advised via radio that he had one male in custody and would be walking back to the scene with the male. I met Ptl. Mijangos near the intersection of Buckeye Road near E. 93rd Street where he turned over a male subject to me, who I later learned to be Decarlo Fields. Decarlo was searched by Ptl. Westfield and placed in the rear of marked Maple Heights Police cruiser number 4423.

I informed dispatch of the VIN # 1FADP3F20GL280735 located on the driver door of the Ford Focus, which was left open. Dispatch informed that the vehicle was entered into LEADS as stolen NIC/V263960163; reference Cleveland PD incident number 2022-00137172.

While on scene, I was informed that a third suspect, later identified as O Fig. , was located at a bus stop. Cleveland PD transported that male to the scene where was positively identified by Ptl. Mijangos as one of the males he observed exit the Ford and flee on foot.

On Monday, May 30, 2022, I, Det. C. Faunce #528, received a call from CVD Dispatch advising a shooting had occurred and that I was need to respond to the scene.

Upon arrival to the city, I responded to the area of Buckeye Rd. and McCurdy Ave. where the pursuit ended. Upon arrival, I met with Chief Hansen who requested I take some photographs of the overall layout of the scene. The photographs show debris from Ambler St. to where final rest was near McCurdy Ave. The vehicle involved had no visible plate but a VIN# 1FADP3F20GL280735. The photographs were burned to a DVD and later entered into evidence.

I was then tasked with processing the scene at 15310 Fernway Ave. I responded to that address and met with Sgt. Voll and Ptl. Lowe. I was shown one, once fired cartridge casing lying in the roadway in front of 15305 Fernway Ave. The once fired cartridge casing was marked with placard #1. I then viewed the front of the residence. I was advised the residence had been previously shot May 7, 2022 (Ref. MA22-10091075).

**Officers note: In report MA22-10091075, three bullet strikes were observed to the front of the residence.

I marked each bullet strike I located with a number and date. I then placed a known measurement sticker next to each strike mark. I located at total of 19 strike marks to the residence and one strike mark to a vehicle in the driveway, a 2008 Chevrolet Cobalt bearing Ohio License HYK3015 with VIN# 1G1AL58F387234047. The bullet strike that was marked as number 20 appears to be a through and through that struck the siding of 15310 Fernway Ave. then struck the west side of 15312 Fernway Ave. I labeled the strike mark to 15312 Fernway Ave. and number 21.

At the time I processed the exterior of the residence I spoke with Chara Thompson who is currently renting the residence. Chara stated she was not currently at home but would respond back in a few hours to meet with me. At approximately 1245 hours, I was advised Chara was home and responded to speak with her. With Chara home to unlock the residence, I took photographs of the interior of the residence. I photographed the damage done by the bullets entering the residence. While following the trajectory of the projectile through the residence, I was able to locate three projectiles that were recovered. One projectile was lodged in the wall of the dining room right at the surface of the wall. A second projectile was located on the top shelf of the built-in display cabinet in the south east corner of the dining room. A third projectile was recovered in the bathtub.

The three projectile's and one once fired cartridge casing recovered by me were later entered into evidence. I was also provided a once fired cartridge casing that was recovered by Ptl. Lowe at the time officers originally responded to the scene. That once fired cartridge casing was later entered into evidence.

While talking to Chara Thomson she indicated two friends were witnesses to the vehicle that drove past and stopped to shoot. Chara agreed to come to the Maple Heights Police Department due to the news cameras being on the street. Chara contacted both Jordanne Jones and her boyfriend Demarco Henderson and asked if they would respond to the Maple Heights Police Department to further discuss the incident.

I spoke with Demarco and Jordanne who provided the following statements:

Demarco stated he was sitting in his car in the street in front of the residence. A grey Ford Focus drove toward Dunham Road with no lights on. The vehicle stopped just behind them and they heard gunfire. Demarco

indicated the driver window was rolled up but the back-driver side was where the shooter was. Demarco saw the muzzle flash but did not see the gun extended out of the car. The vehicle then sped off. The second time the car pulled around Demarco was on the porch floor sitting down when the grey Ford Focus, same car with the lights off, drove up and fired one round. Demarco stated he was staring at the car as it pulled up prior to laying down to hide from the last fired round.

Jordanne stated she was in the car with Demarco when she saw two vehicles driving past fast so she felt like something wasn't right. Jordanne sat in the car then a grey Ford Focus with no lights shot about 6 times and pulled off. The police came and as soon as the police left the same car pulled back up and shot once while me and Demarco were on the porch.

While talking to Jordanne, Demarco and Chara, I had left the interview room so I was not standing other them. At one point I returned and Chara stated she had read on an Instagram page that Datwuan Catchings was the male that was shot and killed in Cleveland after the pursuit. Since it was confirmed by Cleveland Remembrance Page, Chara began to get upset due to knowing who Datwuan was. Chara identifies Datwuan as "Weedy". After taking a minute to smoke a Black-n-Mild for a minute, Chara came back inside and provided the following statement:

I received a phone call from "Weedy" at 1:12 AM (5/29/2022) and asked me to open the door. I open the front door and there was three males. Two I knew and one I never seen before. The second person he was with nickname was "Tae". I went back to my room and went back to sleep as they were drinking and smoking (Marijuana) and talking. About the time 10:00 AM "Weedy" asked for his hair done and I started to wash it and re-twist it. About 2:00 PM "Weedy" went to take his cousin home because it was his birthday and he didn't want to have him waiting on "Weedy" to get his hair done. At 3:30 PM "Weedy" returned with "Tae" and wanted me to finish his hair. We were in my bedroom as I was doing his hair. "Tae" joined us in my room and at this time "Weedy" was sleeping as I did his hair. "Tae" grabbed "Weedy" marijuana and smoked as he talk to me about my friend Jordanne. That's when "Weedy" woke up out of his sleep yelling at us both about his weed (marijuana). "Weedy" felt like we got one over on him. I became really aggressive and that's when I told him I wasn't going to finish his hair because he was accusing me of smoking his marijuana but I never touched it. I only had a Black-n-Mild and hardly even smoked it because I was busy trying to get his hair done. "Weedy" then heard Jordanne come in the house and started accusing everyone of stealing his weed (marijuana). The only person who touched his weed was his younger cousin "Tae". Then "Weedy" left out the house and returned five minutes later. "Weedy" knocked over my table that was in my bedroom with drinking glasses on it breaking them. After he broke the cups by flipping the table, they both left and I blocked Weedy and deleted our messages.

I contacted Cuyahoga County Major Crime Prosecutor Saleh Awadallah and gave him the facts of the case. Cleveland Police are investigating the Use of Force Shooting of the suspect by our officer and he was assigning a special prosecutor for that review. Prosecutor Awadallah put me in touch with Joanna Whinery to get a ruling for charges for the juvenile and suggested I forward the information on the Adult suspect to County Prosecutor T. McKenna for review. The following synopsis was sent with copies of reports and witness statements for review:

We had 2 related shooting into habitation incidents yesterday morning. Both incidents involved the same house and same suspect vehicle. The first incident was at approximately 0300 (MA22-10109588) on 5-30-22 where a gray Ford drove past 15310 Fernway Drive and fired approximately 17 rounds striking 15312, 15310 and an unoccupied vehicle in the driveway of 15310. Both homes were occupied by adults and children at the time of the shootings. Witnesses at both scenes described the suspect vehicle as a gray Ford and that the shots were fired from the passenger side rear window. The second incident (MA22-10109615) occurred only minutes after officers cleared the first shooing scene at 0414 hours. Officers were only a short distance away at our service garage fueling their vehicles when they heard the shots. The suspect vehicle fled on Dunham Road where another officer responding to the call observed the vehicle on Dunham / Old Granger Road traveling at a high rate of speed away from the scene. Officers attempted to stop the vehicle they observed, a silver / gray Ford focus, but it continued to flee from officer who gave chase. The pursuit lasted from 0414 to 0425 hours reaching speeds approaching 100 miles per hour only ending when the subject vehicle struck a deer and crashed. The 3 occupants of the suspect vehicle fled on foot (the driver fleeing while carrying a handgun) and the officers gave chase. The driver fleeing with a gun (Datwuan Kain Catchings 22-years old) was shot by an officer during the foot chase on McCurdy and was later pronounced dead. The other officer apprehended the front seat passenger (DeCarlo Wilbert Fields 27-years old) near 9407 Steinway Ave. The rear seat passenger 17-years old) was later apprehended at a bus stop by Cleveland Police Officer a short time later near Woodhill and Buckeye. The suspect vehicle had no license plate and when the VIN was run was found to be stolen out of Cleveland OCA/2022-00137172.NIC/V263960163. The vehicle was a 2016 Ford Focus Tectonic Silver Metallic (could be described as a light gray) with vin # 1FADP3F20GL280735 and should have had a license plate of HPD6862.

Through further investigation and interviews conducted by the detective bureau we learned that the female occupant / victim of 15310 Fernway had a romantic relationship with the driver of the suspect vehicle (Datwuan Kain Catchings 22-years old) who had spent the night at her residence on Saturday 5/28/22 going into Sunday 5/29/22 and left at approximately 1700 hours (5pm) on Sunday 5/29/22 after an argument where he allegedly believed the occupants of the home smoked all of his marijuana without his consent. This appears to be the motive for the shootings into the home that occurred Sunday night 5/29/22 going into Monday morning 5/30/22 at 0300 and 0414 hours.

On Tuesday, May 31, 2022, I, Det. C. Faunce #528, responded to the Maple Heights Jail to interview DeCarlo W. Fields. Upon entering the Maple Heights Jail, I spoke with DeCarlo in the BAC room.

I started off by advising DeCarlo of his Constitutional Rights which he stated he understood. I explained to DeCarlo that I was requesting a DNA standard from him. I explained that it would be used as a comparison to DNA that would be located off evidence found in the car. The Maple Heights Police Department Consent to withdraw DNA form was completed. DeCarlo Fields again agreed and signed the consent to withdraw DNA. Using sterile cotton swabs, and nitrile gloves, I swabbed the inside of both DeCarlo Fields mouth. I rubbed one swab on his left cheek and the second on his right cheek. The swabs were then placed into a new white box. The box was then placed into an evidence envelope that was later entered into evidence.

I then asked DeCarlo if he was willing to talk with me about the incident. DeCarlo started the conversation by asking about his brother, the driver, who he called "Weedy" being shot and killed. DeCarlo wanted to know why he was shot and killed. I did confirm that his brother was shot by a member of the Maple Heights Police Department but could not comment further due to that investigation being conducted by Cleveland Police Department.

DeCarlo stated he was walking on Clement St. with his bag of clothes and called his brother for a ride. DeCarlo stated he got picked up and sat in the passenger seat of the car. DeCarlo indicated he was coming over a bridge by Granger Rd. DeCarlo stated the Police lights were on but they were not behind them. The Police did a U-turn and got behind them. DeCarlo thought they were just getting pulled over and he didn't stop. DeCarlo began to wonder why he did not stop. DeCarlo wanted him to pull over and let him out. The next thing he knows is after the car hit the deer, he heard a cop told him "I'm going to pop your ass" so he got out and ran. That was it.

I then asked DeCarlo where he was picked up from. DeCarlo again said Clement St. When the vehicle was observed by officers, it was traveling east on Libby Rd. The vehicle was traveling toward Clement St. So, I began to explain to DeCarlo, the locations he is giving me is not possible due to the direction the car was observed traveling. DeCarlo stated after he was picked up they traveled west on Libby Rd. DeCarlo stated he does not know where they turned around (due to the airbag in the crash) if it was the gas station or a U-turn how he was driving east. DeCarlo stated they were driving back over the bridge and the police were coming the oncoming way with the lights on when they did a U-turn. The next thing he knew the car sped up and the driver stated he was not stopping. DeCarlo stated he wanted to get out but he couldn't because the car was going too fast.

I then asked DeCarlo what time he was picked up at. DeCarlo stated it was really late. DeCarlo didn't know exactly when it was he didn't know it was 0400, 0300 or 0430 he just knew it was late. I then asked how long before the pursuit was he picked up. He said it had to be right before. He then stated they picked him up with his bag of clothes and started traveling west. He indicated there was a store but does not remember if they went to the store. DeCarlo can only remember traveling east on Libby Rd. DeCarlo saw the police but didn't know they were going to mess with them. As far as DeCarlo knew there was nothing being done to be stopped by the police because he just got in the car. DeCarlo stated he was in the car long enough for him to get picked up on Clement St. drive west on Libby Rd. and turn around to drive east on Libby Rd. when the police saw him. As soon as they turned around is when the police saw them. DeCarlo stated he does not know if the police saw them turning around but he saw the police coming. Then the police turned around and the high-speed pursuit

happened. DeCarlo stated he had his seatbelt on and put his arms in front of him to brace when he saw they were going to hit the deer. He stated "the air bag knocked him out something crazy." He stated he got a headache and as he was trying to shake it, he heard the police say they were going to "pop" him. DeCarlo then exited the car and began to run because he did not know what was going on and he was scared. He stated he got out because they were saying they did something and he was the only one in the car and he looked crazy too for being in the car. DeCarlo did not want to get treated like he did something. DeCarlo admits he was definitely wrong for running. When the police told him, he was going to "pop him" he ran because the police told it to him again and he did not want to get shot by the police. Then he came to find out the police shot his brother so he had too.

DeCarlo stated he did not want to write his statement out due to it being recorded and him not wanting to do all that writing.

On Munday, May 30, 2022, I, Det. Christopher Faunce #528, stopped at 15408 Fernway Dr. to speak with a resident who was possibly a witness to the shooting.

I was advised on scene in Cleveland, by Ptl. Frazier #540 and Cleveland Police Sgt. Moore #9104, that a female who identified herself as Ginger B. had arrived on scene of the incident and stated the car that was involved was the car she saw shooting at the house in Maple Heights. Ginger was in a gray Audi with Florida plate EURW17. No other information other than a phone number was obtained at that time.

After leaving the scene in Cleveland, I responded back to process Fernway Dr. I observed a gray Audi bearing Florida plate EURW17 parked in the driveway of 15408 Fernway Dr. I asked Ptl. Lowe to contact that resident but he was unable to do so.

When I responded back to Fernway Dr. to process the inside of 15310 Fernway Dr. I observed the front door to 15408 Fernway Dr. open. I responded over and spoke with a female who identified herself as Ginger B. Ginger was later identified as Gindonya Bridges. When I first spoke with Gindonya she stated the following. She was parked in the street in front of her house and a friend of hers was parked directly beside her talking window to window. Her friend said "Damn they must be stealing or something." When her friend said that, she observed a car driving with no lights on traveling west on Fernway Dr. The car did not wait for her friend to move, instead it drove up on the tree lawn on the opposite side of the street to drive around them (three cars wide). The car then stopped and they heard gunshots. They heard approximately 15 gunshots. Another female that was inside the residence with Gindonya also made comments but no identification for that female was obtained. The unidentified female stated she believed they "empties the clip" (indicating fired all bullets from a magazine). Gindonya then stated she turned on a scanner app and the car that shot the house was the same car that crashed on Buckeye Rd.

I then advised the females the reason I was there was due to them going to Cleveland and identifying the car they saw shooting on Fernway Dr. was the same car they told Cleveland Police was on scene on Buckeye Rd.

Gindonya then asked if the car from Buckeye Rd. was the same car Warrensville Heights Police was chasing earlier in the day. Gindonya stated they have shot at that house previously. When asked if they would provide written statements, Gindonya stated they did not want to at this time.

***Officer note: Warrensville Heights did chase a tan Ford but it was not the vehicle involved in this incident ***

On Thursday, June 2, 2022, I responded back to speak with Gindonya and ask her to provide a written statement. Gindonya had been interviewed by the news on May 30, 2022 so I was hoping she would be willing to provide her statement.

Gindonya provided a statement and stated the following:

I was parked on the street and my friend pulled beside me. That's when we seen a car coming up toward Dunham with their lights turned out. They drove up on the curb to get around us. They then pulled up to the house down the street and began shooting at the house. When the police left they came back and shot one more time. When then listened to scanner and went to Buckeye and verified it was the same car.
