APPROVAL—CANAL LAND LEASE EXECUTED BY THE STATE OF OHIO TO M. R. REID OF CIRCLEVILLE, OHIO

Dear Sir: You recently submitted for my examination and approval a canal land lease in triplicate executed by you in your official capacity as Superintendent of Public Works and as Director of said department to one M. R. Reid of Circleville, Ohio.

By this lease, which is one for a stated term of fifteen years and which provides for an annual rental of \$7.50, there is leased and demised to the lessee above named the right to occupy and use for residence and agricultural purposes that portion of the abandoned Ohio and Erie Canal property, including the full width of the bed and embankments thereof, located in Circleville Township, Pickaway County, Ohio, and described as follows:

Beginning at a line drawn at right angles to station 9+63, of W. O. Sanzenbacher's survey of said canal property, said station being two hundred forty (240') feet, more or less, northerly, as measured along the transit line of said survey, from the intersection of the center line of Hargus Creek, and said transit line; thence in a northerly direction with the lines of said canal property, four hundred seventy-nine (479') feet, to a line drawn at right angles to station 14+42, reserving and excepting so much of the above described property that was sold to The Norfolk and Western Railroad Company, in 1911.
