

Narrative:
On April 13, 2022, at approximately 0505 hours, Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Jon Lieber (Lieber) arrived at the Ashtabula Police Department (APD). SA Lieber met with APD Lieutenant (Lt.) SA Lieber photographed as well as documented s duty and backup pistols. The following information was noted:
Lt. (
Duty pistol: Glock 9mm pistol, serial # with one magazine in the pistol containing 17 cartridges plus 1 cartridge in the chamber (18 cartridges total). had 2 additional magazines on his duty belt each containing 17 cartridges. The total number of cartridges for this weapon was 52 (18 + 17 + 17). A Streamlight TLR-1 HL flashlight was mounted to this pistol.
Backup pistol: Glock 9mm pistol, serial # with one magazine in the pistol containing 15 cartridges plus 1 cartridge in the chamber (16 cartridges total).
Note that neither of the above firearms were collected by SA Lieber, as neither weapon was discharged during the incident. The rifle that was discharged by during the incident was located at the shooting scene. That rifle was documented and collected by the BCI Crime Scene Unit.


