Narrative:

On March 16, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent John Tingley (SA Tingley) reviewed the audio recording of phone calls that the Parma Police Department (PPD) Dispatch both received and made related to the officer involved critical incident which occurred on February 24, 2026, at 10810 Brookpark Road, Brooklyn, Cuyahoga County, Ohio.

The audio recording (260010642 Phone_Calls.wav) was 45:38 in length but did not have a date or time stamp listed. Accordingly, the times listed will be the time elapsed from the beginning of the recording.

The listed phone calls do not list all the phone calls contained in the audio recording that covered the time before, during, and after the OICI. Rather, the phone calls listed documents the phone calls received and made by the PPD Dispatch that were deemed by the author to be the most relevant and useful in obtaining an understanding of the information obtained by the PPD dispatchers related to the OICI.

00:04 – Caller (Henry Siekaniec)

"Yes, I have a friend who just texted my friend who I'm with that he just texted him goodbye. And we're both worried he might try to harm himself."

00:32 – Dispatcher

"What's his name?"

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00:34 - Caller

"Ricardo Davis."

02:00 - Dispatcher

"Has he ever tried to harm himself in the past?"

02:03 - Caller

"Yes."

02:06 - Dispatcher

"Has he attempted suicide in the past?"

02:10 - Caller

"Yes."

02:23 - Dispatcher

"Does he have any weapons?"

02:27 - Caller

"Uh, I'm not sure if he has a gun or not. I know he's certified. I dunno if he actually has one."

The dispatcher then asked for the caller's name and was told by the caller, Henry Siekaniec.

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04:01 – Caller (Mobile Crisis Team)

"Hi. This is Ashley with the Mobile Crisis Team. Um. I'm calling for a wellness check."

This call from the Mobile Crisis Team was also requesting a welfare check on Ricardo Davis.

06:49 – Dispatcher

The dispatcher called Verizon Wireless Security Assistance to check on a ping for Ricardo Davis' phone. The dispatcher was notified that Ricardo Davis' phone provider was AT&T.

08:33 – Dispatcher

The dispatcher called AT&T and started a ping on Ricardo Davis' phone with the location updated every fifteen minutes. The notifications from AT&T were sent to an email at the PPD and therefore do not show up in the later phone calls.

14:03 – Dispatcher

The PPD dispatcher called Brooklyn Police Department (BPD) and notified them of the OICI. The PPD dispatcher also requested that the BPD send officers and a Brooklyn Fire Department squad to the scene of the OICI.

30:40 – Caller (Unidentified)

"Hi. I'm a clinician...and I received another, um, text from one of my previous clients that I do not see anymore. But the text said goodbye...I tried to text and call my, my old client and I didn't get a response. So, I think a well check is warranted here."

31:03 – Dispatcher

"What's his name?"

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31:04 – Caller

"Ricardo Davis."

The dispatcher then notified the caller that the PPD was out with Ricardo Davis without going into further detail.

31:50 – Caller (Roosevelt Davis)

"Yes, my name is Roosevelt Davis, and my son Ricardo Davis is a former psyche, psychiatric patient and he just sent myself and his sister and brother a cryptic message where he said goodbye. Now he has attempted suicide in the past and we're all concerned because no one can reach him, haven't been able to get ahold of him since that message today."

The dispatcher notified Roosevelt Davis to contact the Metro Health Main Hospital in Cleveland for further information about his son Ricardo Davis.
