At the 00:50 mark, [REDACTED] exited his vehicle and pointing his duty weapon at the white Jeep SUV while giving the commands, "put the car in gear, do it now." Immediately thereafter, the Jeep backed into the black SUV.

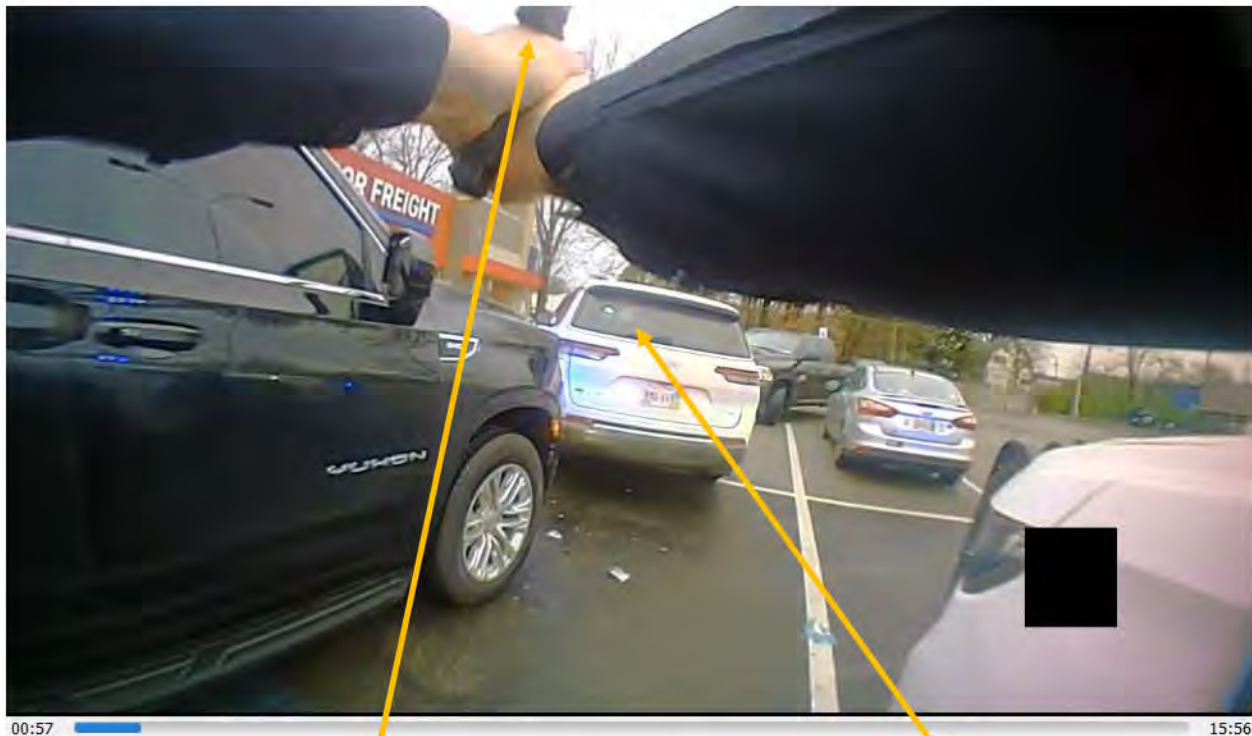

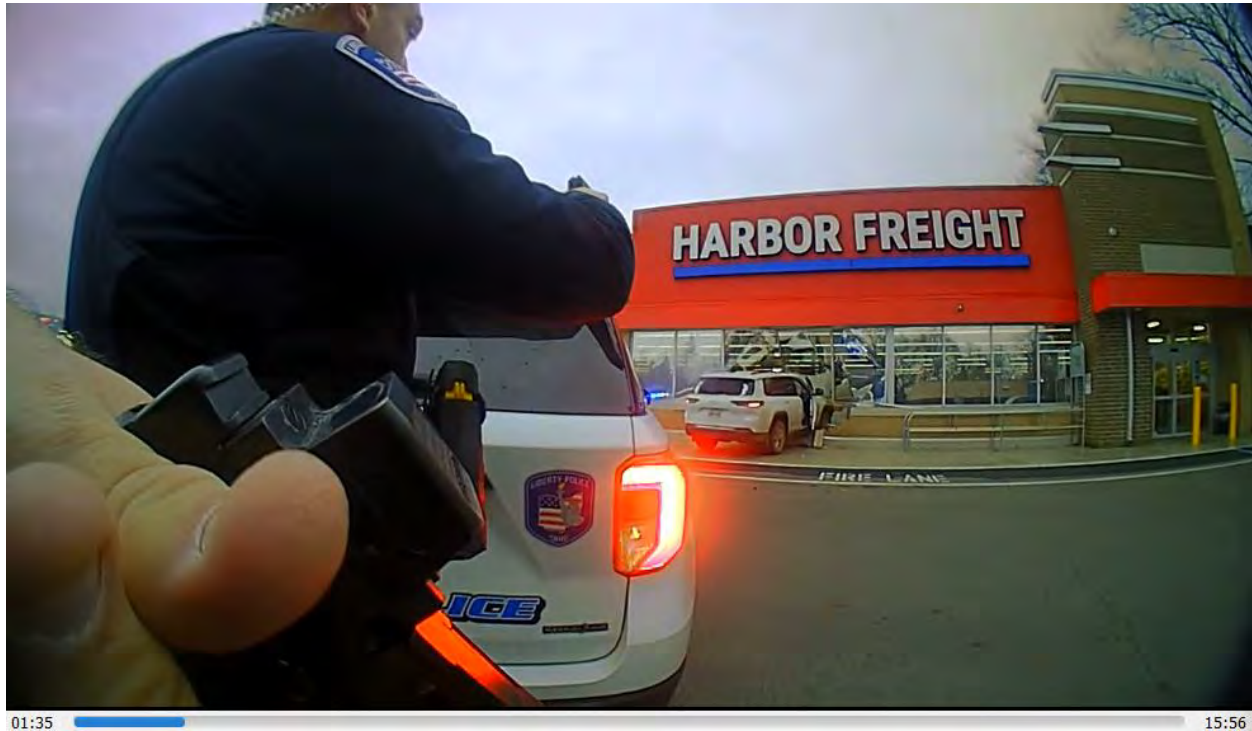

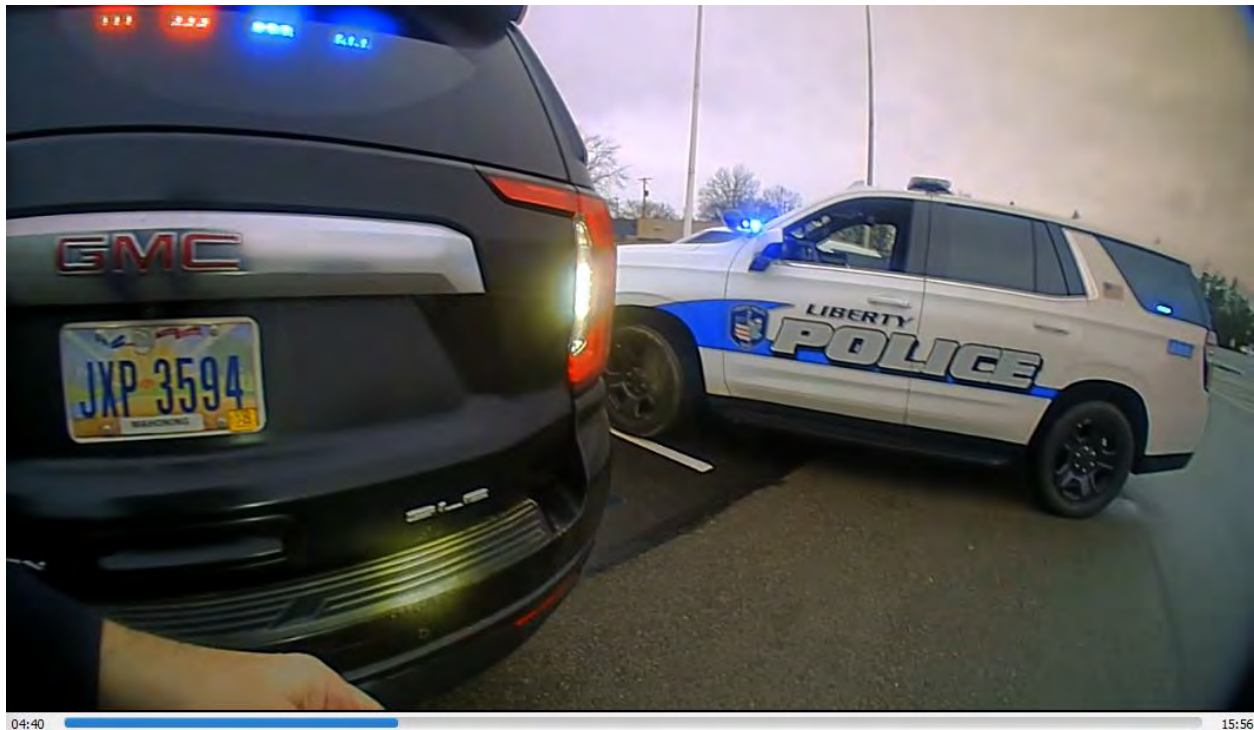

Shortly after assisting Detective Altier and Officer Rice with clearing the vehicle, [REDACTED] said he was having trouble holstering his duty weapon because his light fell off his gun. [REDACTED] asked Officer Rice to assist him by checking inside the holster to see if the light fell down inside it.

At the 04:40 mark, after [REDACTED] and Officer Rice made their way behind Captain Buhala's black SUV, [REDACTED] fixed the light attachment for his duty weapon. At that time, [REDACTED] was heard saying, "Well, he hit Ray, and I was worried that he was going." Officer Rice was then heard interrupting [REDACTED] saying, "yea, I know, I know, and then he was going to ram the other car, you're good."

This video file began with Officer Brandon Rice (Rice) arriving at 3487 Belmont Avenue, the parking lot of Harbor Freight, and exiting his Liberty Township Police Department (LTPD) vehicle to assist the other officers by attempting to box in a white Jeep sport utility vehicle (SUV) that contained stolen license plates out of Hermitage, Pennsylvania. Furthermore, it was later discovered that the vehicle itself was reported stolen out of Sharpsville, Pennsylvania.

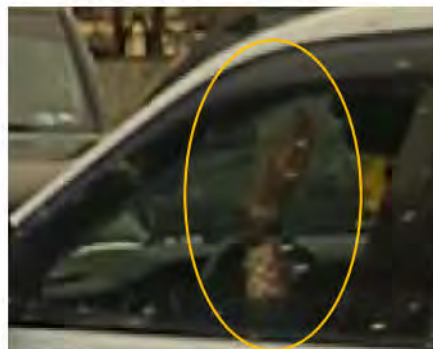

ADDITIONAL FACTORS FOR EVALUATING THE VIDEO RECORDINGS

There are numerous other factors that need to be considered when reviewing and evaluating the videos and audio recordings of this incident. Those factors are:

A. Video recording devices record within the video and sound capabilities available, and they record objectively. Video recordings lack the history, perspective, and interest of the people involved. The positions, angles, obstacles, lighting, and distance from the incident are also factors that need serious consideration.

B. Video recording devices also record more information about a particular scene or incident than the person(s) involved in the incident can process during the critical incident. Video recording devices rarely record an event from the same perspective of the officer. It captures the action but not the perception, decision making, focus, or intent of the officer. Video recordings often miss tactile cues or other actions of a subject.

C. The speed of the incident is remarkable. The speed and complexity of rapidly evolving situation(s) that occur during use of force encounters are difficult concepts to comprehend by only watching the video.

The video files were provided via a Watchguard internet link. The video footage was downloaded and saved in the Northeast shared drive as item A for reference only. The photo snippets from the respective video file are attached.
