McConnell asked if Nathaniel lived there (507 Ritchie), and Shawntea said that Nathaniel lived somewhere around the University of Akron.

Shawntea said that Nathaniel came over to wait for his dad so he could celebrate his twenty-first birthday. Shawntea stated that, "for some reason he just lost it and started acting crazy."

Shawntea said that "he (Nathaniel/Lawrence Rogers) was walking around and all the sudden he started pointing a gun at him."

Shawntea stated he woke his brother up (Raymond Jones) to try and talk to Nathaniel to calm him down.

Shawntea stated that the officers showed up and Nathaniel would not let anyone go to the door.

Shawntea said that Nathaniel was pointing the gun at Raymond, so he and Damian went out the side door.

The officers pulled them (Shawntea and Damian) out of the house and took them to separate cruisers.

Shawntea stated that he was in the police car when he heard the shots fired.

Shawntea said that the only people left in the house were, "his brother Raymond and Nathaniel (Lawrence Rogers)."

Williams asked Shawntea how long Nathaniel was there. Shawntea said Nathaniel had been there for a few hours hanging out. Shawntea stated that he had not seen Nathaniel

Crime Scene Unit Detectives J. Soroky 1063 and S. Sabol 1036 responded to the scene around 07:00 hours.

Once the search warrant was signed, they assisted BCI Investigator Justin Soroka with processing the scene and the collection of evidence.

Lawrence Rogers Heckler & Koch 9mm Pistol:

- Ten cartridge casings recovered from the scene matched Rogers pistol.
- BCI's results were inconclusive (see definition in report) about the seven recovered bullets from Raymond Jones autopsy.
