Narrative:

On March 13, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent John Tingley (SA Tingley) reviewed the audio recording (Police_Radio.wav) received from the Parma Police Department (PPD). The audio recording is of the radio traffic from PPD Officers and PPD Dispatch related to the Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) which occurred on February 24, 2026, at 10810 Brookpark Road, Brooklyn, Cuyahoga County, Ohio.

The summary below is not intended to be a word for word translation of every radio transmission which occurred, before, during, or after the incident. Rather, the information listed documents the radio traffic that was deemed by the author to be the most relevant and useful in obtaining an understanding of the radio traffic related to the OICI.

As there is no date or time stamp on the recordings, the time listed will be the elapsed time from the beginning of the audio recording.

The recording is listed as: Police_Radio.wav and is 29:54 in length.

00:01 – Dispatch

"A welfare check. 5433 Norwood, number 8. Check on 29-year-old Ricardo Davis. Caller got a message from him just saying goodbye. The male in question has attempted suicide in the past."

00:45 – Dispatch

"...Last time we did a welfare check on him he was driving a 2015 red Toyota, Juliet Sierra Fox 3645 (JSF 3645)."

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Officers responded to the apartment but were unable to contact anyone at the apartment door.

02:23 – Officer

"Radio. Go ahead and send, uh, maintenance with the keys. Got some notes on the door."

02:59 – Officer

■ and I are on a welfare check...He's got some vague notes on the door saying he has harmed himself..."

Officers then made entry into and checked the apartment after building maintenance arrived and let them in via master key.

04:06 – Officer

"All right. He's not in the apartment. Uh, maybe try a ping."

04:38 – Officer

"...He's definitely, uh, I think gonna try to kill himself. He's got notes all over the place about information for his death certificate..."

05:15 – Officer

"I think we're gonna go out and look for his car."

05:50 – Officer

"...And I just presume that he's armed. He's got receipts here from Parma Armory for, uh, Taurus handguns."

Multiple Officers then began to check the area for Ricardo Davis (Davis). Dispatch was also requested to "ping" Davis' phone.

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08:04 – Dispatch

"Units, checking the last ping showing, uh, area 9687 Brookpark..."

08:58 – Officer

"I think I got the car up here by Sam's Club. Just turned westbound on Brookpark. Yeah, I got it, Juliet Sierra Fox 3645 (JSF 3645)..."

09:14 – Officer

"Alright, he is not stopping yet."

09:24 – Officer

"He's reaching in the back seat. I think he has a gun..."

09:31 – Officer

"Shots fired. Shots fired. Male down. Start PFD (Parma Fire Department) now..."

Officers then approached and secured Davis. The officers also immediately began first aid and continued treatment until the PFD Squad arrived. Davis was transported to Metro Health (Main) Hospital where Davis succumbed to his injuries.
