Narrative:

On Monday, June 01, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) John Tingley (SA Tingley) reviewed video footage from the Crawford County Sheriff's Office (CCSO). SA Tingley was informed that the videos contained footage from the body worn cameras (BWC) recorded by Officer Alyssa Detillion (Detillion) and Lieutenant David Rowland (Rowland) and the dash camera video from Lieutenant Rowland's cruiser. The videos were related to the Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) which occurred on March 11, 2026, at 905 East Warren Street, Bucyrus, Crawford County, Ohio.

The listed narrative is a synopsis of the activities recorded on Officer Detillion and Lieutenant Rowland's BWC and Lieutenant Rowland's cruiser's dash camera and only documents those activities which the author deems to be the most relevant to the OICI. Furthermore, the narrative does not cover all the activities, conversations, or radio traffic recorded. Nor is the synopsis a word for word translation, except where so marked and identified, of the conversations, radio traffic, and/or activities of the law enforcement personnel present or dispatch. It is suggested that the full recording be reviewed to clarify any content or contextual questions.

There was a total of three (3) BWC videos reviewed, one (1) from Officer Detillion, and two (2) from Lieutenant Rowland. Furthermore, there was one (1) dash camera review from Lieutenant Rowlands CCSO cruiser.

It should also be noted that Deputy Detillion was training with Lieutenant Rowland who was her Field Training Officer (FTO).

SA Tingley reviewed the video recordings and noted the following:

This video begins on March 10, 2026, at 23:05:17 hours, is 01:30:01 in length, and starts as Deputy Detillion was in the front passenger seat of a cruiser which was moving and being driven by Lieutenant Rowland.

At approximately 23:05:33 hours, the cruiser stopped and Deputy Detillion exited the cruiser.

At approximately 23:06:08 hours, Deputy Detillion moved the cruiser to block the roadway.

At approximately 23:07:02 hours, an unidentified Bucyrus Police Department (BPD) Officer notified Deputy Detillion and her FTO, Lieutenant Rowland, that Paul Desmarais (Desmarias) had charges pending and that Desmarias also had a weapon and had threatened "to end" any officer entering his property.

Deputy Detillion then took cover behind a cruiser and helped to maintain the perimeter. During this time, an unidentified BPD officer used the public address (PA) system on a BPD cruiser to repeatedly call for to come out and surrender.

The video concluded with Deputy Detillion helping to maintain the perimeter.

Lieutenant David Rowland

This video begins on March 10, 2026, at 23:03:03 hours, is 01:31:58 in length, and starts as Lieutenant Rowland was in the driver's seat of a moving cruiser.

At approximately 23:05:35 hours, the cruiser stopped and Lieutenant Rowland exited the cruiser.

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At approximately 23:07:02 hours, an unidentified Bucyrus Police Department (BPD) Officer notified Lieutenant Rowland and CCSO Deputy Detillion that Paul Desmarais (Desmarias) had charges pending and that Desmarias also had a weapon and had threatened "to end" any officer entering his property.

Lieutenant Rowland then took cover behind a cruiser and helped to maintain the perimeter. During the time Lieutenant Rowland was maintaining the perimeter, an unidentified BPD officer used the public address (PA) system on a BPD cruiser to repeatedly call for to come out and surrender.

The video concluded with Lieutenant Rowland sitting in his cruiser which was still on the perimeter.

Lieutenant David Rowland

This video begins on March 11, 2026, at 00:48:12 hours, is 20:03 in length, and starts as Lieutenant Rowland was standing outside a cruiser.

At approximately 00:48:49 hours, Lieutenant Rowland contacted Desmarais' son (the name of the son is not mentioned and he is not identified).

At approximately 00:48:50 hours, Desmarais' son stated that he knew what weapons his father had.

Lieutenant Rowland then asked what the weapons were.

At approximately 00:48:55 hours, Desmarais son stated that Desmarais had an M-1 Garand with black tip armor piercing rounds, a Level 4 Body Armor Vest with multiple ballistic plates, two (2) M-16 rifles with green tip armor piercing ammunition and a .40 caliber pistol on his person.

Lieutenant Rowland then asked where Desmarias kept the weapons.

At approximately 00:49:34 hours, Desmarais' son replied that the weapons were kept in the bedroom.

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Lieutenant Rowland then asked where Desmarais bedroom was located. Desmarais' son pointed out the window but stated that there was a slot machine in front of the window which would block the view into the room.

At approximately 00:50:10 hours, Desmarais' son stated that Desmarais had over three thousand (3000) rounds of the green tip armor piercing ammunition in the house.

Lieutenant Rowland then texted CCSO SWAT Team Commander Lieutenant Mosier the information that he had learned.

The video then concluded with Lieutenant Rowland still seated in his cruiser.

Lieutenant Rowland's Cruiser Videos:

There are three separate categories of video recordings from Lieutenant Rowland's cruiser. There is: the Dash Camera - Normal View; Dash Camera - Wide View; and Cruiser Rear Sear View. Within each of the three categories, there are seven (7) separate videos for each which were reviewed for a total of twenty-one (21) video recordings.

However, all the twenty-one (21) video recordings reviewed used the same identifier of M505-003800. Therefore, the individual videos will also be listed by the date and time that the video recording began, which will clearly separate the timing of the individual video recordings.
