Narrative:

On Tuesday, January 13, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Allison Fletcher (Fletcher) submitted items to the BCI Laboratory (lab case number 26-30331) for analysis. The following 11 items were submitted:

- Eight (8) fired cartridge cases – 5.56 (Matrix Evidence Item #32 and #34-40)
- One (1) – DB15; Multi; AR15 rifle, S/N: DB2205448 with damaged magazine lodged in the mag well (Matrix Evidence Item #33)
- One (1) fired projectile (Matrix Evidence Item #48)
- One (1) UIC; Multi; AR15 Rifle S/N [REDACTED], magazine with 18 unfired cartridges and 1 from the chamber, suppressor, light, Aimpoint optic, and sling (Matrix Evidence Item #51)

The analysis requested was to determine if the UIC Multi AR15 rifle collected from [REDACTED] fired the recovered projectile and eight 5.56 NATO cartridge casings collected at the scene. Operability testing was requested for each submitted firearm, and NIBIN entry was requested for the submitted rifle belonging to the involved subject. The lab submission receipt is attached to this report.

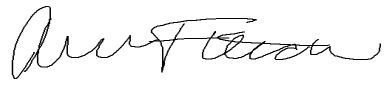
