## Search Warrant Obtained

Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Jon Lieber (Lieber) drafted a search warrant for DoorDash, Inc., 901 Market Street, 6<sup>th</sup> Floor, San Francisco, CA 94103, <u>LERT@DoorDash.com</u>, relative to the officer-involved critical incident which occurred on June 27, 2022.

On Tuesday, July 05, 2022, SA Lieber met with Summit County Court of Common Pleas Judge Alison McCarty (Judge McCarty). Judge McCarty reviewed the search warrant, search warrant affidavit and request/order to seal. On July 05, 2022, at approximately 1421 hours, Judge McCarty signed/authorized the search warrant.

## Search Warrant Executed

On Tuesday, July 05, 2022, at approximately 1449 hours, SA Lieber executed/served the aforementioned search warrant by emailing a copy of the warrant to LERT@DoorDash.com.

On July 06, 2022, at 1722 hours, DoorDash responded to the search warrant by emailing DoorDash account information and delivery information for Jayland Walker.

An inventory of the items seized was prepared with a copy provided to the Summit County Court of Common Pleas.

## Search Warrant Returned

On Friday, July 08, 2022, SA Matt Armstrong met with Judge Kelly McLaughlin (Judge McLaughlin). Judge McLaughlin reviewed and signed the search warrant return. On July 08, 2022, SA Armstrong filed the original search warrant, search warrant affidavit, inventory, motion to seal, order to seal and search warrant return with the Summit County Clerk of Courts.
