Dear Sir:—This is to acknowledge the receipt of a recent communication over the signature of the chief of the bureau of inland lakes and parks of the division of conservation in your department, submitting for my examination and approval a certain reservoir land lease in triplicate executed by the conservation commissioner to one John Griffiths of Akron, Ohio. By the lease here in question, which is one for the stated term of fifteen years and which provides for an annual rental of six dollars, there is granted and demised to the lessee above named the right to occupy and use for boathouse, docklanding and walkway purposes the waterfront and state land in the rear thereof that lies immediately in front of Lot No. 23 of the Sours Second Allotment, East Reservoir, Portage Lakes.

Upon examination of this lease, I find that the same has been properly executed by the conservation commissioner and by the lessee above named. I also find, upon examination of the provisions of this lease and of the conditions and restrictions therein contained, that the same are in conformity with sections of the General Code relating to leases of this kind.

I am accordingly approving this lease as to legality and form, as is evidenced by my approval endorsed upon the lease and upon the duplicate and triplicate copies thereof, all of which are herewith returned.
