Narrative:

On Tuesday, January 27, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) John Tingley (SA Tingley) reviewed the requested audio recording of the radio traffic from the Euclid Police Department (EPD) related to the officer involved critical incident (OICI) which occurred on January 21, 2026, at 24496 Clareshire Drive, North Olmsted, Cuyahoga County, Ohio.

The summary below is not intended to be a word for word translation of every radio transmission which occurred before, during, or after the incident. Rather, the information listed documents the radio traffic that was deemed by the author to be the most relevant and useful in obtaining an understanding of the radio traffic related to the OICI.

As there is no date or time stamp on the audio recording provided by the EPD, the times listed will be the elapsed time from the beginning of the recording. The audio recording can be found documented as "Radio Traffic" and can be found as Reference Item E which is stored in AXON JUSTICE. The overall length of the audio-recording is 19:54. All of the officers on the audio recording are EPD Officers. Where known, the officers will be identified by name. Other references listed simply as "officers" will be for unknown/unidentified officers.

It should also be noted that the large breaks in places of the documented radio transmissions are when the pursuit was occurring and the units involved were calling out the speed, direction of the pursuit, traffic volume, and roadway conditions (wet, dry, etc.).

SA Tingley reviewed the radio traffic audio recording and noted the following which is documented in the following table:

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Time of Recording	Radio Traffic
00:01	EPD Dispatch set off the emergency tone and notified Officers of an armed robbery of a Brinks truck at gunpoint at the AT&T store on West River Road
00:15	Suspect vehicle was a black Hyundai Crossover with Ohio license plate KPM 5569, Vehicle is northbound on West River Road from the store.
00:30	Suspect described as a black male wearing all black clothing.
00:36	Officer directed EPD Dispatch to notify the Lorain Police Department (LPD) of the incident.
00:48	Unknown officer notified other units that suspect vehicle was last hit on the Flock cameras at 1449 hours at State Route 57 and IR 90 traveling northbound
02:16	EPD Officer House gives further description of the suspect as 6'2 to 6'3, thin, light skin black male.
04:56	EPD [REDACTED] notified dispatch that he was with LPD units and that they were in pursuit of the suspect vehicle.
05:04	Pursuit southbound on Broadway Avenue.
05:15	EPD units directed to assist LPD with the pursuit with LPD as the lead in the pursuit.
06:32	EPD units notified that the suspect was wanted for Aggravated Robbery with a firearm and kidnapping.
15:40	Dispatch notified that the pursuit had entered North Olmsted.
16:17	EPD units notified that LPD terminating their lead in the pursuit and requesting that RPD take over as primary in the pursuit.
16:51	Dispatch notified units in the pursuit that a Lorain County Sheriff's Office (LCSO) unit was going to attempt a pit maneuver (did not occur).
18:20	Officer notified dispatch that the suspect's vehicle tires had been successfully "spiked"
18:42	Dispatch notified that the suspect's vehicle had struck another vehicle and that the suspect was fleeing on foot.
18:49	Officer gave suspect description as a black male wearing a gray hoodie and blue jeans.
18:56	Officer called "Shots fired".
19:45	Officer notified dispatch that LCSO radio traffic advised that shots were fired and the suspect was down. Gives the address as 24496 Clareshire Drive, North Olmsted.

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Shortly after the last documented radio transmission, the audio-recording ended.
