Narrative:

On December 30, 2020, at approximately 1349 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agents Jenny Comisford (SA Comisford) and Jon Scale interviewed Upper Arlington Fire Division (UAFD) Captain Donald Ingersoll (Captain Ingersoll). The voluntary interview was conducted at Upper Arlington Fire Station 72, located at 3861 Reed Road, Upper Arlington, OH.

The purpose of the interview was to discuss Captain Ingersoll's response to an Officer Involved Critical Incident (OICI) on the morning of December 22, 2020 at 1062 Oberlin Drive, Columbus, OH, involving the Columbus Division of Police and a male later identified as Andre Hill (Hill).

The conversation was audio recorded and a copy of the recording was saved electronically within the case file. Please refer to the attached audio for complete details. The following is a summation of Captain Ingersoll's interview.

Captain Ingersoll confirmed that he and UAFD Paramedics Paul Hill and Kenneth Packard (Packard) were dispatched to 1062 Oberlin Drive on the morning of December 22, 2020 on report of a shooting. Captain Ingersoll advised that a Columbus Fire Department (CFD) medic was also dispatched and responded to scene. Responding UAFD units were informed that police were on scene and it was safe for EMS to make entry upon arrival.

Captain Ingersoll approximated the distance between Upper Arlington Fire Station 72 and 1062 Oberlin Drive as two miles. He advised it was approximately three minutes from the time UAFD marked enroute until they arrived on scene. Captain Ingersoll was the responding UAFD supervisor. He reportedly followed UAFD Medic 72 to scene. He recalled their route from the station as right on Reed Road, left on Fishinger Road, left on Kenny Road, and right on Oberlin Drive.

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Captain Ingersoll reported that UAFD arrived on scene prior to CFD. UAFD Medic 72 was able to park directly in front of the residence, while Captain Ingersoll parked his vehicle approximately two houses from the incident location in order to keep his vehicle out of the way.

Upon arrival, Captain Ingersoll saw police cruisers and police officers “everywhere.” He walked up the driveway and observed an unidentified male CPD officer performing chest compressions on an individual who was laying on the ground parallel to the open garage door (later identified as Hill). Captain Ingersoll did not converse with that officer, and was unaware when CPR began.

At that point, Captain Ingersoll and Packard retrieved medical equipment from the UAFD medic, to include a cot, red bag, and an “AutoPulse” device (automatic CPR machine). CFD Medic 19 and CFD EMS 13 (CFD officer) reportedly arrived on scene around the same time.

Captain Ingersoll explained that Hill was “hooked up” to an EKG monitor which revealed Hill’s heart rhythm to be asystole, or no heart activity. The sweater and undershirt worn by Hill were cut off by EMS personnel, exposing what appeared to be a wound to Hill’s chest. Hill was placed on the cot where he was attached to the AutoPulse device. Hill was then moved to UAFD Medic 72.

Captain Ingersoll advised he was not in the medic at any point, and subsequently did not witness what medical aide/procedures were performed by UAFD or CFD paramedics. Captain Ingersoll confirmed he did not personally render aide or touch Hill.

Hill was transported to Riverside Hospital. Captain Ingersoll confirmed Riverside was the nearest hospital, and transport time was approximately two minutes. Two unknown CFD paramedics and one CPD officer also rode in UAFD Medic 72 during transport.

Captain Ingersoll advised that at one point in time, the officer he originally witnessed performing chest compressions was relieved by another (unknown) CPD officer who took over compressions. Captain Ingersoll was unaware of any additional aide rendered to Hill prior to his arrival. Captain Ingersoll did not discuss the details of the OICI with any officers or persons on scene, nor did not notice any property on the ground near Hill.

Throughout the interview, Captain Ingersoll confirmed the below listed times documented on the attached UAFD Patient Care Report:

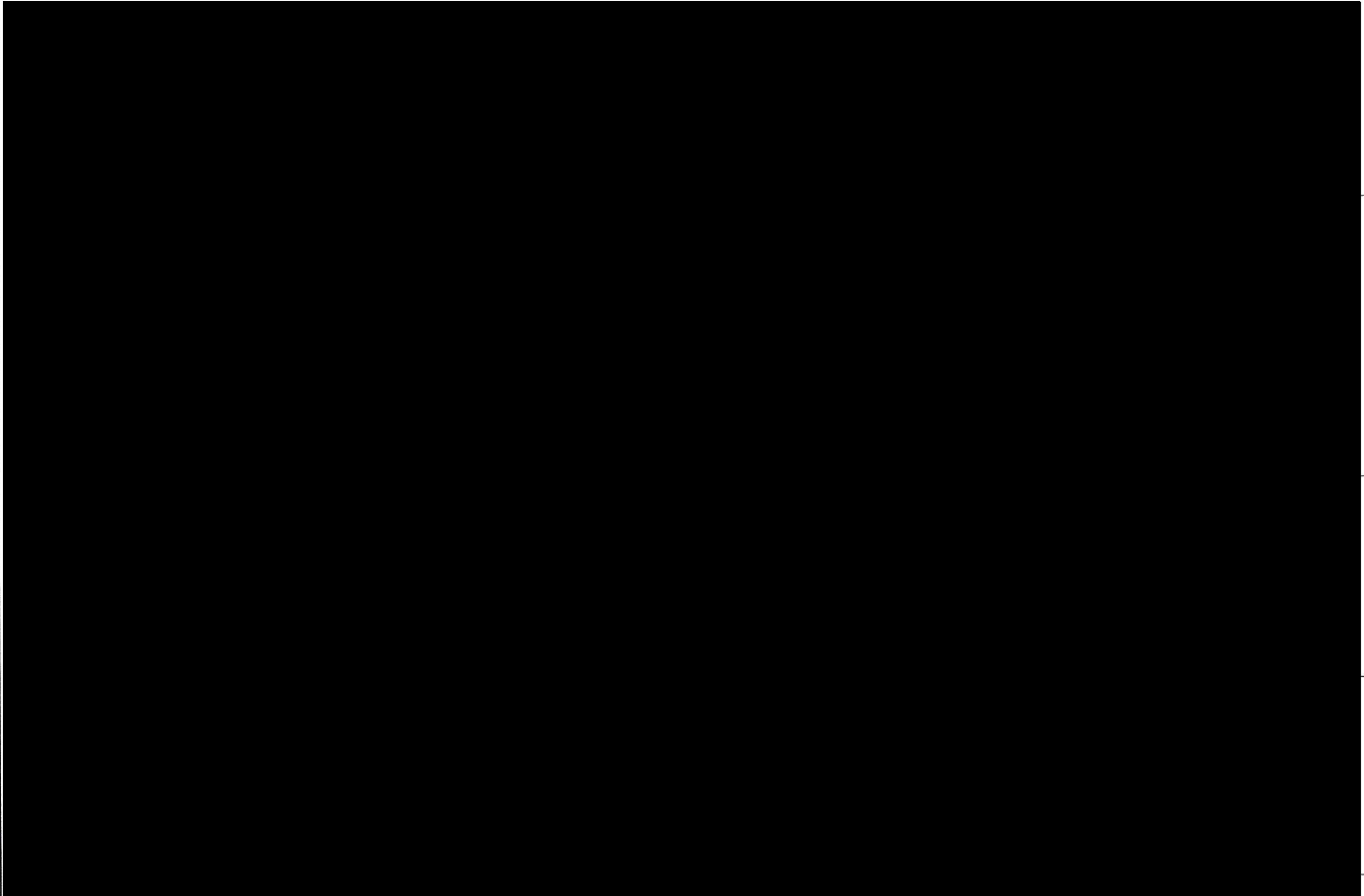
