Re: Bonds of Montgomery county in the amount of \$189,000 for the improvement of I. C. H. No. 62, Section "Q," Dayton and Granville road—being ten bonds of \$9,000 and nine bonds of \$11,000.

Gentlemen:—I have examined the transcript of proceedings of the county commissioners and other officers of Montgomery county relative to the above bond issue, and find the same regular and in conformity with the provisions of the General Code.

I am of the opinion that said bonds, drawn in accordance with the legislation authorizing their issuance, will, upon delivery, constitute valid and binding obligations of said county.

I note that the resolution of the industrial commission purchasing the bonds provides for the purchase of one bond of \$18,000 and nine bonds of \$19,000, whereas the bond resolution of the county commissioners of Montgomery county provides that the issue be divided and fall due as follows:

"One \$9,000 bond on April 1st of the following years: 1922, 1923, 1924, 1925, 1926, 1927, 1928, 1929, 1930 and 1931, and one \$11,000 bond on October 1st of the following years: 1922, 1923, 1924, 1925, 1926, 1927, 1928, 1929 and 1930."

I suggest that the resolution of the industrial commission be amended so that there may be no confusion hereafter as to the denomination of the bonds purchased.
