**Narrative:**

On Tuesday, January 20, 2026, at 1811 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Kyle Douglass (SA Douglass) and SA Amanda North (SA North) interviewed ██████████ relative to the officer-involved critical incident which took place on Tuesday, January 20, 2026. The interview took place at ██████████. Also present during the interview was ██████████, who identified herself as ██████████, and Pickaway County Sheriff's Office (PCSO) Detective Michael Oberley (Det. Oberley). The purpose of the interview was to obtain all relevant information about the incident known or observed by this individual.

██████████ reported she currently resides at ██████████. ██████████ explains she lives there with ██████████ and his baby daughter. ██████████ has been living with ██████████ since ██████████ babysits ██████████ daughter as part of their living arrangement. ██████████ and ██████████ are not romantically involved. On the date of the incident, ██████████ was babysitting ██████████ daughter ██████████. ██████████, Chase Dalton (Chase), had spent the previous night there. ██████████ left for work at approximately 0900 hours.

██████████ explained she was doing laundry when Chase reportedly assaulted her. ██████████ stated Chase punched her and grabbed her neck. ██████████ said Chase forced her into ██████████ bedroom, pulled up her dress and tried to remove her underwear. ██████████ explained she pushed and kicked Chase in an effort to stop the assault, after which Chase smacked her in the face hard enough to make her ears ring. ██████████ reported Chase held her down and attempted to penetrate her but "couldn't get it inside" and his penis started bleeding.

██████████ indicated Chase finished his assault and afterwards made her "cuddle" on the couch with him and watch a movie. ██████████ said Chase then demanded that she take

a shower with him, which [REDACTED] initially refused. [REDACTED] reported Chase punched her again, after which she complied and got into the shower with him. After showering with Chase, [REDACTED] went to [REDACTED] bedroom to get dressed. [REDACTED] recalled Chase entered [REDACTED] bedroom and forced her to bend over on the floor. [REDACTED] said Chase began lubricating her with lotion and then forced penetration on her with his penis. [REDACTED] indicated she experienced severe pain during the act.

[REDACTED] explained the baby ([REDACTED] daughter) woke up, at which point she asked Chase to stop, and Chase allowed [REDACTED] to go check on her. Chase told [REDACTED] he had to get something out of his car and attempted to take [REDACTED] cell phone with him. [REDACTED] convinced Chase to let her keep her phone. "As soon as he walked out the door, I deadbolted the door and locked the handle and I grabbed a knife, [REDACTED], and my phone and I locked myself in the bathroom and called the cops," [REDACTED] stated.

[REDACTED] called 911 at approximately 1451 hours. While [REDACTED] was on the phone with the 911 dispatcher, Chase was screaming at her to let him back into the house and was banging on the door from outside. [REDACTED] was still on the phone with 911 when Chase attempted to shoot the deadbolt lock off the exterior door with a gun and force his way back into the house. [REDACTED] had not seen Chase with a gun that day but was aware Chase kept firearms in his vehicle. [REDACTED] reported Chase drives a black Nissan sedan. [REDACTED] described the gun she had seen preciously as being dark green and black. [REDACTED] estimated Chase fired five to six gunshots into the door.

[REDACTED] recalled hearing the police arrive, shortly after which she heard a "series" of gunshots. [REDACTED] could hear the police shouting verbal commands to Chase to drop his gun. [REDACTED] then heard police officers trying to gain access to the house, after which she exited the bathroom and opened a back door to allow police inside. Police officers immediately took [REDACTED] out of the house. [REDACTED] believed that [REDACTED] may have been present during the shooting incident or shortly after.

During the interview, [REDACTED] indicated Chase had made threats towards her mother and her brother. "He was telling me that if I didn't comply, if I didn't listen to him, he was gonna go kill my mom and my brother," [REDACTED] stated.

[REDACTED] discussed potential evidence of the sexual assault which could be found inside the house. [REDACTED] described a red towel in her bedroom which might contain biological evidence, and a white towel which Chase forced her to put in the washing machine. [REDACTED] said the couch had also been moved while she was fighting with Chase. [REDACTED] indicated the couch was moved out of place before Chase forced her

into [REDACTED] bedroom. [REDACTED] also believed there would be paper towels in the kitchen trash can and possibly in the bathroom toilet with Chase's blood on them. [REDACTED] described the lotion Chase used during the incident as a white and orange bottle with a brand name 'Native' and mango scented. [REDACTED] also believed Chase had ejaculated inside her. "That's why I want the rape kit," [REDACTED] stated, and indicated she had gone to [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] reported several indications in the past regarding Chase's behavior towards her. [REDACTED] recalled moments when Chase would become heavily intoxicated and be "touchy feely" with her. [REDACTED] believed [REDACTED] had addressed this behavior with Chase and thought it would no longer be an issue. [REDACTED] also recalled an incident several weeks ago when Chase had come into her bedroom while she was naked, and she told him to get out. [REDACTED] also added that prior to the date of the assault, Chase had apologized to her for his past behavior.

On the date of the incident, [REDACTED] described Chase's attack as "out of the blue" and had not seen any indications from Chase that he might attempt to sexually assault her. [REDACTED] also reported that after Chase had assaulted her, he showed her a previously recorded video on his cell phone of himself touching and rubbing [REDACTED] while she was asleep on the couch and said, "I've been watching you." [REDACTED] estimated Chase's attacks happened over the course of between one and two hours, sometime after 1145 hours when she put [REDACTED] daughter down for a nap.

The interview concluded at approximately 1842 hours.
