Narrative:

On April 1, 2021, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigations Special Agents Richard Ward and Perry Roeser along with Ohio Attorney General Special Prosecutor Anthony Pierson and Micha Ault met with Dystanie Lydelle at 1062 Oberlin Drive for the purpose of trial preparation. Lydelle was present when Adam Coy shot and killed Andre Hill on December 22, 2020.

During the approximately 30 minute meeting with Lydelle, she provided additional details about the incident. According to Lydelle, Adam Coy after approaching Hill in the vehicle Hill was siting in, had driven away then returned prior to confronting Hill a second time when Hill was shot.

This trial preparation was not recorded.
