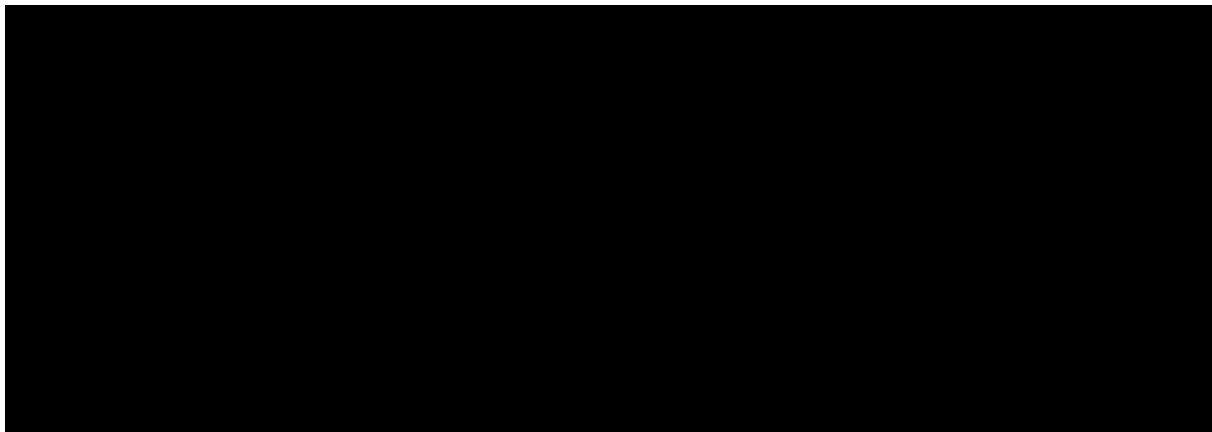

Narrative:

On Monday, June 15, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Joseph Goudy (SA Goudy) reviewed the "Firearms Trace Summary" reports from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF). The reports contained information about the firearms that Matthew Metzger (Metzger) possessed during the incident on May 24, 2026. The report provided details about the following firearms:

- Canik55 - 9mm pistol - SN: 20BN08631
- Bergara Firearms BXR - 22 caliber Rifle - SN: TA004580
- DPMS - A15 - 223 caliber rifle - SN: FH226321

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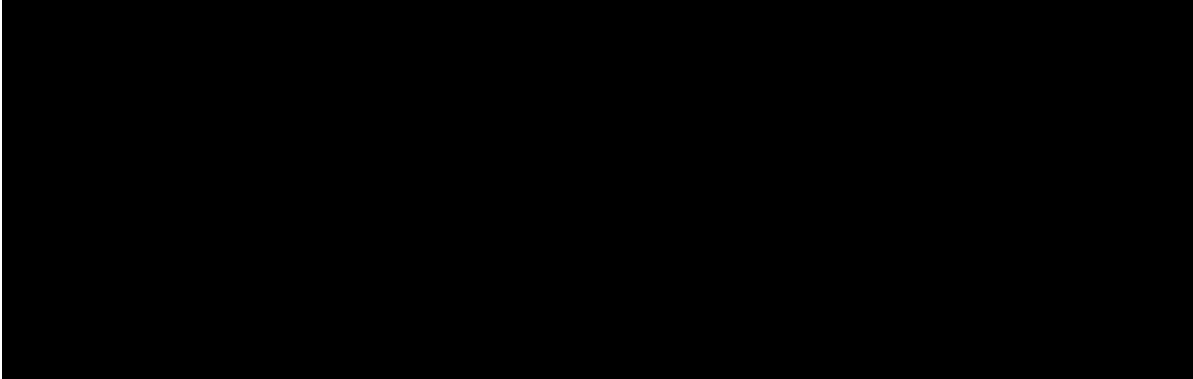
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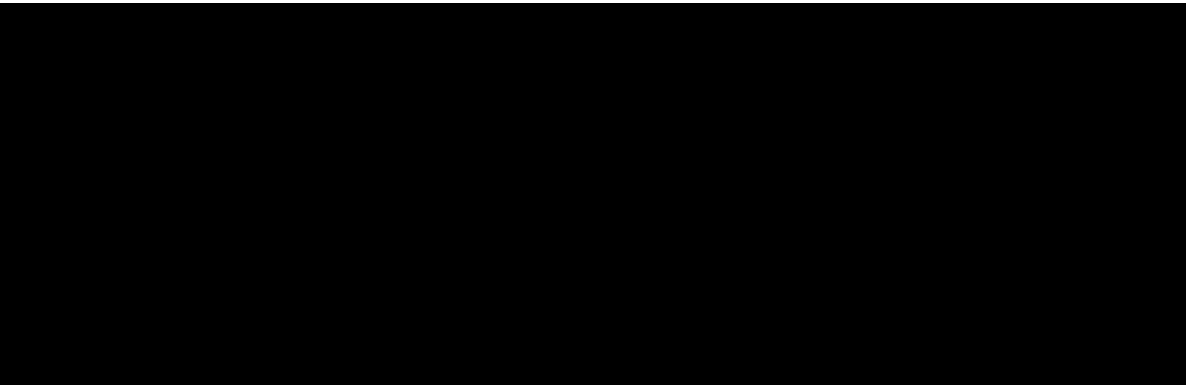
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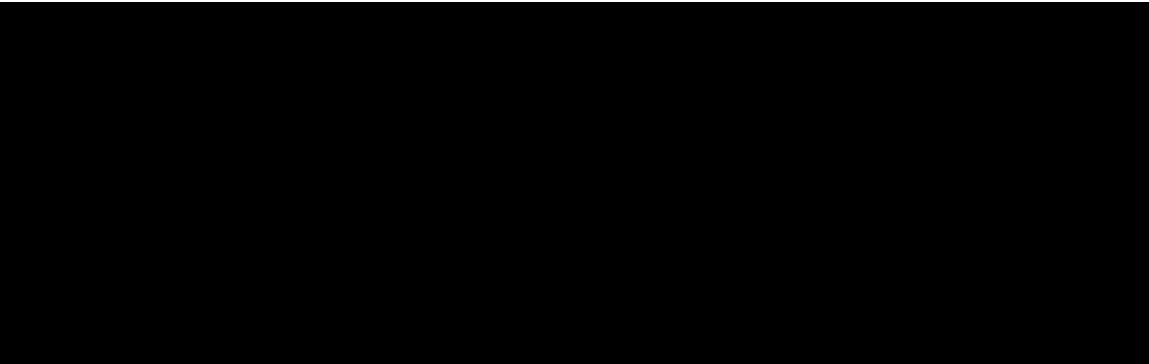
