Narrative:

On Friday, April 15, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Jon Lieber (Lieber) received the Ohio BCI Laboratory report for an item of evidence submitted on April 13, 2022, for scientific analysis (laboratory case number 22-33189). The report originated from the DNA section of the laboratory and was authored by Forensic Scientist David M. Ross. The item relevant to this report, which had previously been submitted, is as follows:

1. One cardboard box containing firearm – Remington 870 Express Magnum (Serial # B573172U) (Matrix #1)

SA Lieber reviewed the laboratory report and noted the following:

The BCI laboratory swabbed the trigger, trigger guard, grip, stock, forend, breech block and front sight area of the shotgun for possible DNA. These samples are being retained for potential future DNA analysis; however, at this time, the swabs have not been submitted to analysis.
