Gentlemen:—I have examined the transcript submitted this department in connection with the foregoing issue and am compelled to disapprove the same for the following reasons:

The board of education in this instance is endeavoring to issue those bonds under section 7630-1, of the General Code, and upon orders issued by the inspector of workshops and factories, department of industrial relations, after an inspection made on January 9th and 10th 1922.

These orders make requirements for alterations and improvements in eight school houses of this district, but in no instance has the department of industrial relations prohibited the use of either building for school purposes.

Section 7630-1 is an emergency measure and provides for the issuance of bonds when a school building has been destroyed by fire or other casualty, or when the use of the building for school purposes has been prohibited by the department of industrial relations. No such prohibition exists in any of the orders submitted.

It is therefore my opinion that these bonds are not valid and legal obligations of the district and I advise the Industrial Commission not to purchase them.
