Narrative:

On Saturday, October 19, 2024, the Mansfield Police Department requested assistance from the Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) at the scene of an officer-involved critical incident at 200 Cline Ave. Mansfield, Ohio. As part of that investigation, Special Agent (SA) Kenneth Smith was requested to attend the post-mortem examination of the decedent. The examination was conducted on October 21, 2024, at the Montgomery County Coroner's Office in Dayton, Ohio. The post-mortem examination was conducted by Dr. Kristan Abernathy.

The autopsy began at 07:59 hours and was concluded at approximately 11:50 hours.

The following observations were made during the course of the autopsy:



SA Smith requested to receive a copy of the full autopsy and toxicology reports once available.

As a result of the autopsy, the following items of evidence were collected and transferred to the custody of SA Smith:

1. Clothing from Oswalt

The aforementioned items were subsequently transported to the BCI office in London, Ohio, where they were submitted to the investigations evidence vault for later transport to Richfield. The evidence transfer sheet documenting the exchange is attached to this investigative report.
