Narrative:

On May 11, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Investigation (BCI) Special Agent David Hammond (SA Hammond) and Special Agent Joseph Goudy (SA Goudy) contacted Lexington Police Department [REDACTED] at the Ontario Police Department, located at 555 Stumbo Rd N, Ontario, Ohio, 44906.

[REDACTED] was involved in the officer involved critical incident which occurred on May 11, 2026, at 905 E. Warrant Street in Bucyrus, Crawford County, Ohio.

SA Hammond and Goudy introduced themselves to [REDACTED] and explained the process regarding the BCI investigation. At the time of the meeting, [REDACTED] indicated that he thought he would be represented by the Fraternal Order of Police (FOP) but wasn't sure. [REDACTED] was provided with a copy of the Marsy's Law packet. [REDACTED] advised that he was familiar with the packet and would return it to agents if needed. [REDACTED] indicated that he would meet with his attorney and schedule an interview at a later date.

Photographs of [REDACTED] were taken by Sergeant Jered Kingsboro shortly after the incident took place. The photographs were provided to BCI by the Lexington Police Department. They were uploaded to Axon Justice labeled as Reference Item L - Photographs of [REDACTED].

On May 12, 2026, SA Hammond was contacted by FOP Union Representative Jessica Franken (614-264-7147 - jfranken@fopohio.org). She advised that she was representing the Mansfield Officers who were part of the ASORT tactical team. She advised that she was working to locate representation for [REDACTED]. She advised that she would be in contact to set up possible interviews in the first week of June.
