On 06/22/2022, S/A Hammond contacted the Latent Print Section of BCI at the Bowling Green Office. Fingerprint standards obtained at autopsy were submitted to the lab to verify Quincy Pritchett's identity from previously submitted print card. For additional information please refer to the BCI Lab Submission form.

On 06/23/2022 at 1111 hours, Inv. # 15 and 21 were removed from temporary locker #2 and taken to the crime scene processing area. Personal protection equipment was used. Inv #15 was opened to confirm the contents due to no number being marked on the bag. A new opening was created and the contents verified (spare magazines and ammunition from the gun belt). The packaging was resealed and marked with a sticker (glove change).

Inv. #21 was then opened. This was the cardboard box containing the Taurus Handgun from the scene. The package was opened to verify that the fired bullet (jacketing and lead) from the handle was inside the box, packaged in a manila envelope. This was verified and the packaging was resealed.

Items # 15 and 21 were returned to temporary locker #2 at 1139 hours.

S/A Hammond had an opportunity to speak with SAS Stranahan and S/A C. Hamberg about the case and potential items of evidence that would be tested. Per the conversation and investigation goals, several items of evidence (Inv. # 2, 3, 4, 5, 9, 20, 21, 22, A6 and A17) were removed from temporary locker #2 and submitted to the lab for potential testing (06/23/2022 at approx. 1500 hours).
