**Narrative:**

On Friday, October 17, 2025, at 0900 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Darien Spann (SA Spann) interviewed Keith Decumbe (Decumbe), of the Brunswick Fire Department (BFD), relative to the officer-involved critical incident which occurred on Thursday, September 18, 2025. The interview took place at BCI - Richfield. The purpose of the interview was to obtain all relevant information of the incident known or observed by this individual regarding their response to the incident scene.

Decumbe said he was at the fire station when they received the call for an individual who had cut their arm. As they were en route they were advised they needed to hurry up to the scene. Decumbe stated that when he arrived at the scene, he saw a lot of blood inside of the store. He then saw the officers and Jacob Derkin (Derkin). Decumbe and the other medics attempted to assess Derkin, but the room they were in was too dark and he had to move Derkin outside to properly assess his wounds. Once they got Derkin into a better lit area, medics were able to determine Derkin was not breathing at that point in time. Once on the ambulance Decumbe went through a cardiac arrest protocol, Derkin was [REDACTED] which meant [REDACTED] Decumbe stated that Derkin was [REDACTED] on the ambulance, and he made no statements.

The interview concluded at approximately 0920 hours.
