Narrative:

On Monday, October 24, 2022, at 1036 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Chuck Moran (Moran) received an email from BCI Criminal Investigation Unit (CIU) Analyst Jamie Papesh. The email contained background information compiled by BCI CIU on Jeremy McCracken, a subject involved in the incident on October 5, 2022. The information included researching past police reports involving the subject, searching criminal history records, court records (if applicable), open/closed-source database inquiries and social media posts. The records were compiled in a 153-page PDF document labeled, “Jeremy A McCracken – Work Up.”

SA Moran reviewed the information and noted the following:

Pages 37-118 – These pages consisted of a CLEAR report for Jeremy McCracken. It listed possible addresses, relatives, associates and other information.

Pages 119-123 – These pages were Summit County Auditor records for the property located at 2347 East Waterloo Road, Akron, Summit County, Ohio 44312.

Pages 124-125 – These pages contained information about a federal court case, McCracken v. Springfield Township, Summit County, Ohio et al., in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Ohio. It listed Jeremy McCracken's name and Springfield Township, the Springfield Township Police Department, Kellie Chapman, Joe DiLauro, Dean Young, Allan Swift and Jack Simone. The court case number was 5:2022CV01413. The federal statute listed was 42 U.S.C. § 1985 Conspiracy to Interfere with Civil Rights.

The docket report listed five filings. The first was filed by Jeremy McCracken of a complaint against Kellie Chapman, Joe DiLauro, Jack Simone, Springfield Township Police Department, Allan Swift, Township of Springfield, Summit County, Ohio, and Dean Young.

Filing three was a motion for a temporary restraining order by Jeremy McCracken.

Filing four stated, "Memorandum of Opinion and Order For the reasons set forth herein, Plaintiff's Motion to Proceed In Forma Pauperis (ECF No. #2) is granted, his Motion for Temporary Restraining Order (ECF No. #3) is denied, and this action is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. 1915(e). The Court certifies, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. 1915(a)(3), that an appeal from this decision could not be taken in good faith."

Filing five stated, "Judgment Entry For the reasons stated in the Court's Memorandum of Opinion and Order, this action is dismissed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. 1915(e). Further, the Court certifies pursuant to 28 U.S.C. 1915(a)(3) that an appeal from this decision could not be taken in good faith. Judge Benita Y. Pearson on 8/31/2022."

Pages 126-131 – These pages contained screenshots from Jeremy McCracken's personal website, mccracken.itgo.com/contact.html. It provided some background information about Jeremy McCracken. It also provided his political views about a variety of topics.

It stated the following, "I'm also a big opponent of the improper use of eminent domain, and I am a member of the Castle Coalition, a PAC based on limiting the use of eminent domain."

There were two videos about the police radio traffic from a search for the Boston Marathon bomber. There was one video about the air traffic recording from Unit Air Flight 93 on September 11, 2001.

Pages 135-138 – These pages contained screenshots from Jeremy McCracken's Facebook account.

Page 139 – This page contained a screenshot from Jeremy McCracken's Instagram account.

Page 140 – This page contained a screenshot from Jeremy McCracken's Twitch account.

Pages 141-151 – These pages contained screenshots from Jeremy McCracken's Twitter account. There were multiple retweets of firearm-related tweets. Jeremy McCracken also tweeted about firearms. He also tweeted about the officer-involved shooting in Akron involving Jayland Walker.

Pages 152-153 – These pages contained the obituary for Jeremy McCracken.

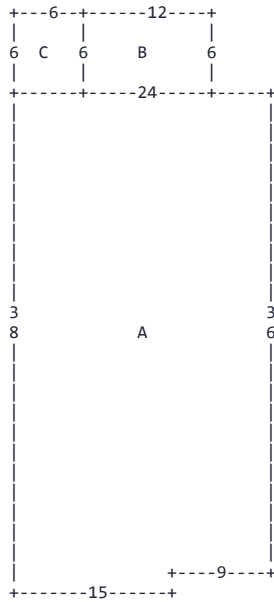

My positions	
Abortion	Pro-choice
Affirmative action	Opposed: it says that people of a different race are inherently different. They aren't.
Budget & Economy	Low taxes, defecits are okay in a poor economy (typical republican-style). In addition, large corporations often stifle smaller businesses and some, including Microsoft and WalMart, should be split.
Civil rights	Always very open. Flag burning and dsnouncing the U.S., while wrong in many ways, are legal and protected. Banning these acts would go against the intention of the country.
Crime & Punishment	In cases of addiction, rehabilitation should come first, and if the offender continues, then the law should apply. For example, a good penalty for drunk driving would be rehabilitation for the first offense, coupled with a three-strike policy. I am in favor of legalization of marijuana and am against the war on drugs.
Death penalty	I am opposed to it, not because of the humanitarian aspect, but because it voids the accused's right to appeal.
Education	Education is of the utmost importance. It was what allows someone to rise from poverty. Education must receive a high level of funding, and supercedes welfare programs. Often, education is the cure for unemployment.
Energy/Oil	Ethanol is a great solution, as it combines a decrease in oil consumption with a replacement of farm subsidies. While strict mileage standards would lower the cost of oil, I am against the idea, as people should be free to choose their own vehicles.
Foreign policy	The United States has a responsibility to help struggling nations. This includes removing brutal dictators. The Iraq War was justified, and in large part, sucessful. We must also contribute foreign aid to help developing countries develop- mostly in technology.
Gay marriage	I would like to see it totally legal. Marriage is a government contract separate from religion, as defined by the separation of church and state. It should apply to any two people. Since many areas don't agree, it would be best to leave it to each state, and I will continue to push for Ohio to end its policy of discrimination.
Gun control	I'm against it. As per the fourth amendment, citizens may own firearms with out restriction. The previous assault-weapon ban was pointless as it was based on cosmetic aspects; additionally, assault weapons aren't used in most robberies, handguns are. I like Ohio's conceal-carry licensing policy and would like to see it national.
Health care	It should be provided to a limited extend to those who can't afford it. This is already the national policy, through Medicaid.
Immigration	It is a great idea, as long as the subject undergoes security clearence. Illegal immigration needs to be dealt with, via a better barrier along the Mexican border.
International Trade	It can not be totally free, as we in the U.S. can't compete with lower minimum wages in other countries. Sometimes tarrifs are necessary when the importing nation has much lower working standards.
Minimum wage	There is a natural equilibrium of wages. The minimum wage should only be put above that if it is very low. In Ohio, it is about \$6.00 per hour. The new minimum wage of \$6.85 is a detriment and will hurt small businesses.
Moral values	Morals are in the eye of the beholder. The government should never legislate morality.
Social security	It will continue to get worse. Don't prop up an already failing system, replace it. I am in favor of privatization.
Welfare	It should be limited. In most cases, a better education would solve the poverty problem.

I summary, I'm in favor of the Iraq war, the war on terrorism, supply-side economics, and limited government involvement, and I'm against restricting rights to homosexuals, banning abortion, and prayer in schools.

I'm also a big opponent of the improper use of eminent domain, and I am a member of the [Castle Coalition](#), a PAC based on limiting the use of eminent domain.

Religion

I am a christian, but, as the paragraph above states, I'm not in favor of government involvement. I prefer the phrase, "Live and let live."
