Details:

On June 28, 2022, at approximately 1200 hrs., S/A Justin Soroka arrived at 800 Dan St. in the City of Akron and met with S/A Cory Momchilov. S/A Momchilov had obtained a search warrant for the vehicle through the Summit County Court of Common Pleas. The vehicle had been towed from the scene to a secured garage, which was located at the Akron Police Department's training facility.

S/A Soroka photographed the vehicle, a 2005, silver Buick Century, bearing Ohio license plate HON 4514, as it was found. The vehicle appeared to be in the same condition as when it was towed from the scene. The exterior of the vehicle was examined. The driver door window was in the down the position, and the remaining windows were partially down. The driver side rear door and passenger side rear door were both found to be locked. There was no power to the power door locks or power seats, which may have been caused by a dead battery. A defect was observed in the leading edge of the driver door. The defect was photographed with a scale. The defect was tested with Cuprotesmo, which is a test for copper, and Pumbtesmo, which is a test for lead. Both tests showed negative results.

The interior of the vehicle was photographed as it was found, and appeared to be in the same condition as when it was towed from the scene. A gold, wedding style ring was still observed on the driver seat bottom. The gold ring was collected and identified as item #1. The interior of the vehicle was searched. A Samsung cell phone was located in the center console, and S/A Soroka was able to place the phone in

airplane mode. The phone was collected and identified as item #2. Nothing further of potential evidentiary value was located.

All items collected were sealed and initialed by S/A Soroka. An inventory receipt was completed by S/A Soroka, and a copy of it was placed in the vehicle along with a copy of the search warrant. The items collected were transported to the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation in Richfield, where they were secured in temporary evidence locker #10.
