On Friday, March 18, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) John Butterworth (SA Butterworth) received training records from Clinton Township Police Department (CTPD) Chief Michael Jones for Officer SA Butterworth reviewed the training records and noted the following:

### Range Qualification Records

Records indicated that on December 1 2021, Officer qualified with the Staccato P-DUO2011 pistol. The firearm listed on the record of proficiency listed the same serial number, as the firearm that was recovered by BCI Crime Scene Unit Agents. In addition to the Staccato pistol, Officer has qualified with several other firearms including non-lethal weapons.

### Subject Control Training

No additional subject control training was listed that would have been in addition to any subject control training from attending the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy. Officer Training at the Delaware JVS graduating in 2001.

### Crisis Intervention Training

Records received from Clinton Township Police indicate that Officer received and completed Crisis Intervention Training on July 14 and 15, 2021, at the Clinton Township Police Department. Officer has attended several crisis intervention trainings and received initial Crisis Intervention Training from Columbus Police on October 23<sup>rd</sup> to the 27<sup>th</sup> 2006.

### Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy/Commission Records

In addition to the records received from the Clinton Township Police Department, SA Butterworth also obtained the Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission (OPOTC) and Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy (OPOTA) records pertaining to Officer

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1. Basic Training

Records from OPOTC indicated Officer **Exercise** attended the Delaware Joint Vocational School Law Enforcement Academy. Date of certification was listed as August 10, 2001.

2. Advanced Training

In addition to the basic OPOTC/peace officer academy, Officer has attended several advanced trainings from OPOTA. Advanced training included Arrest, Search and Seizure, Managing Patrol Operations, Domestic Violence Refresher, Policing in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century: Use of Force and De-Escalation Webcast, Undercover Narcotic Investigation, Semi-Auto Pistol Instructor, Police Rifle-Carbine Instructor, Firearms Weapon Training and Requalification Instructor, Firearms Instructor, Field Training Officer (FTO) Program (Ohio Model), Advanced Tactical Weapons Training, Mobile Active Threat Response, Warrant Service Operations, Instructional Skills (80 Hours), Scenario Based Training Instructor, Judgmental Firearms Simulator (3 times), Policing in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century: Community Policing Relations Webcast, and Judgmental Driving Simulator (2 times).

3. Employment History

According to OPOTC records received, Officer **Constant** is currently employed full-time with the Clinton Township Police Department. Records also indicated that Officer **Constant** had previously been employed part-time with Clinton Township Police Department and the Gahanna Police Department in January of 2001.

4. Update Training

OPOTC records indicate that Officer is up to date on CPT update training as of December 2018.

### 5. Instructor Training

Officer holds numerous instructor certificates from both OPOTC and other sources. Instructor certificates include firearms, instructional skills, Conductive Energy Devices, Stops and Approaches, and Scenario Based Training from OPOTC. Instructor certificates from the NRA, Taser Training Academy, and the Midwest Tactical Applications Group include training for instructing Single Officer Response to the Active Threats, firearms instructor and Taser.

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### 6. <u>Current Peace Officer Status</u>

Based on the records received, it is noted that Officer was a duly certified and sworn Ohio Peace Officer at the time of this incident.

The training documents received from the Clinton Township Police Department and OPOTA/OPOTC were attached to this report. Please refer to the attachments for further details.

According to Rule 109:2-1-12(D) of the Ohio Administrative Code, persons who have previously been certified by the Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission and have had a break in peace officer service for less than one year may be re-appointed as a peace officer, but must complete any specialized training that has been mandated for re-appointed officers. In the case of the above-referenced individual, no such training mandates apply. Accordingly, no additional training is required at this time.

Note that this determination is made based upon information and documents submitted by you and the individual in question. Should the information provided prove inaccurate, this determination becomes void.
