Narrative:

On Thursday, January 29, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) John Tingley (SA Tingley) reviewed the requested audio recordings of the radio traffic from the Lorain County Sheriff's Office (LCSO) related to the officer involved critical incident (OICI) which occurred on January 21, 2026, at 24496 Clareshire Drive, North Olmsted, Cuyahoga County, Ohio.

The summary below is not intended to be a word for word translation of every radio transmission which occurred before, during, or after the incident. Rather, the information listed documents the radio traffic that was deemed by the author to be the most relevant and useful in obtaining an understanding of the radio traffic related to the OICI. Accordingly, only a small number of the actual transmissions will be documented. For further details, please refer to the individual audio recordings.

The date and time for each of the documented audio transmissions will be observed in the identifier assigned to each transmission which lists the date and time of the transmission. All of the audio recordings can be found documented as "Radio Traffic" and can be found as Reference Item E which is stored in AXON JUSTICE. All of the law enforcement personnel on the audio recording are LCSO Deputies. Where known, the Deputy will be identified by name. Other references listed simply as "Deputy" will be for unknown/unidentified LCSO Deputies.

It should also be noted that the large breaks in the times of the documented radio transmissions are when the pursuit was occurring and the units involved were calling out the direction of the pursuit, traffic volume, and roadway conditions (wet, dry, etc.).

Deputy Stinka notified dispatch that he, Deputy Csizmada, and Deputy Bing were standing by in the area of the intersection of State Route 57 and Mayfield Road to check for the armed robbery suspect from Elyria.

LCSO Dispatch notified deputies that the armed robbery suspect's vehicle was a black Hyundai Crossover bearing Ohio license plate KPM 5569.

Deputy stated that the Lorain Police Department (LPD) had initiated a pursuit of the robbery suspect's vehicle and that the pursuit was southbound on Broadway Avenue.

Deputy stated the pursuit of the robbery suspect was now traveling southbound on Elyria Avenue from 31st Street.

Dispatch notified LCSO units that the suspect in the pursuit was wanted for aggravated robbery with a weapon and kidnapping charges.
