Narrative:

On Tuesday, February 24, 2026, at approximately 1434 hours, the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) was requested by Chief Scott Mielke of the Brooklyn Police Department (BPD) to conduct an independent investigation of the facts and circumstances surrounding an Officer-Involved Critical Incident which occurred in the area of 10810 Brookpark Rd., Brooklyn, OH, Cuyahoga County, 44144. Officers from Parma Police Department (PPD) had initiated a traffic stop just inside the jurisdiction of the city of Brooklyn, OH.

BCI Special Agent Douglas Burke (SA Burke) responded to assist, arriving at approximately 15:02 hours. Also responding from the BCI Force Investigations Unit were Lead Special Agent Joe Goudy (LSA Goudy), SA Joe Lamping (Lamping), SA Jesse Bynum (Bynum) and SA John Tingley (Tingley). Additionally, the BCI Crime Scene Unit was requested to process the scene by documenting and collecting pertinent evidence. Crime Scene Special Agent (CSSA) Dave Hammond (Hammond) and CSSA Ed Lulla (Lulla) responded to the scene.

The shooting incident involved a subject, Ricardo Yuuki Davis (Ricardo) and two (2) officers from Parma Police Department (PPD). The incident resulted in the death of Ricardo.

SA Bynum and SA Tingley conducted the initial neighborhood canvass by speaking with witnesses in the area of 10810 Brookpark Rd., Brooklyn, OH, which is a business/corporate area located within the city of Brooklyn, OH and city of Parma, OH, Cuyahoga County. The shooting incident took place on the roadway in the area of 10810 Brookpark Rd., Brooklyn, OH.

A copy of the request for assistance letter is attached to this investigative report.
