**Narrative:**

Over the course of this investigation, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Ryan Emahiser obtained a search warrant from the Wood County Court of Common Pleas authorizing execution of a search of the Apple iPhone that was seized from the 2000 Red Chevrolet pickup driven by Blake Fleure (Blake) during the officer involved critical incident. BCI's Cyber Unit conducted an analysis of the device, and their report is included in this case file.

SA Emahiser reviewed the report of the extracted information, and the following are the items believed to be relevant to the investigation. Also, while conducting a review of the device report, it was found there were numerous devices besides Blake's device reporting activity to the Apple iCloud account for which the report encompasses. SA Emahiser made contact with the Cyber Unit regarding the additional devices, and they were unable to parse out the information specific to Blake's Apple iPhone. The Cyber Unit advised they would detail their findings regarding the multiple devices syncing to the same Apple iCloud account in their report. One example of the issues found was Eric Fleure's call to Seneca County Sheriff's Office 911 from phone number [REDACTED] [REDACTED] shows in the report provided by the Cyber Unit in the call detail records for Blake's Apple iPhone. Photos that appear to belong to other family members also appear in the report that are likely from other devices linked to the same Apple iCloud report.

The following is a review of those items found to be of interest to the investigation in the Cellebrite report and does not contain all of the items in the report provided by the Cyber Unit. It is recommended that the reader review the Cellebrite report in its entirety for a full understanding of its contents.
