Narrative:

On Friday, [REDACTED], the investigation regarding the officer-involved critical incident that occurred in Euclid, Ohio, on January 11, 2026, was presented to a Grand Jury in the Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas by Special Prosecutor Steven Dever. The Grand Jury declined to file criminal charges regarding the actions of [REDACTED] in relation to the death of Robert Riddlebarger.

Special Agent Allison Fletcher and Special Agent Supervisor Charles Moran reviewed this investigation and discussed the documentation. During this discussion, it was determined that the investigation was sufficiently pursued and all investigative efforts and aspects of this case have been completed. Special agent assistance is no longer required by the requesting agency.
