Narrative:

On Sunday, October 12, 2025, at approximately 0421 hours, the Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) was requested by Sergeant Terry McConnell (Sgt. McConnell) of the Columbus Division of Police (CPD) to conduct an independent investigation of the facts and circumstances surrounding an officer-involved critical incident which occurred in the area of 1444 North High Street in Columbus, OH. BCI Special Agent Kyle Douglass (SA Douglass) responded to assist, arriving at approximately 0615 hours. Also responding from BCI were Special Agents James Gore (SA Gore), Matt Collins (SA Collins), Amanda North (SA North), Doug Eveslage (SA Eveslage), and Perry Roeser (SA Roeser). Additionally, the BCI Crime Scene Unit was requested to process the scene by documenting and collecting pertinent evidence.

The shooting incident involved a subject, Tashawn Davis (Davis), and officers from CPD. Officers from the Ohio State University Police Department (OSUPD) also responded to the incident location. The incident resulted in Davis being transported to Grant Medical Center, where he was pronounced deceased. No law enforcement officers were injured during the incident.
