Narrative:

On Tuesday May 24, 2022, Special Agent Shane Hanshaw (SA) Hanshaw traveled to the Montgomery County Coroner's Office located at 361 West 3rd Street in Dayton, Ohio. At approximately 1016 hours, SA Hanshaw took possession of the evidence collected during the autopsy of Devon Taylor (Taylor).

When Taylor was originally transported to the Montgomery County Coroner's Office he was listed as John Doe. On Friday May 20, 2022, Taylor was positively identified by way of fingerprints. The original coroner's evidence collection sheet states John Doe because Taylor had not yet been identified.

On Tuesday May 24, 2022, at approximately 1118 hours, SA Hanshaw deposited the evidence collected from the autopsy into Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) temporary locker number 2.

On Wednesday May 25, 2022, SA Matthew Austin (Austin) submitted multiple items from the original scene located on State Route 339 in Washington County and items collected from the autopsy to the BCI laboratory located at 1560 State Route 56 SW in London, Ohio.

The evidence sheet obtained from the Montgomery County Coroner's office and BCI Laboratory sheet, Lab number 22-14838, are attached to this report.
