Narrative:

On March 05, 2021, at approximately 2350 hours, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agents Jim Mulford (SA Mulford), Rick Ward (SA Ward), and Chad Holcomb (SA Holcomb) conducted a walk-through at the scene of a fatal shooting incident between Andrew Teague (Teague) and members of the Columbus Division of Police (CPD) and Franklin County Sheriff's Office (FCSO).

FCSO Deputy Michael Severance and CPD Officer John Kifer volunteered to participate in individual scene walk-throughs accompanied by their FOP attorneys Nicole Wannemacher and Cathrine Harshman.

They were asked basic "Public Safety" questions and confirmed with agents their locations when they fired their weapons.
