

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Investigative Report





2024-3775 Officer Involved Critical Incident - 1055 East Avenue. Akron, Ohio 44307, Summit County

Below is the narrative portion of Officer Dylan Ostrander's report.

#### ACTION TAKEN:

I, Officer Ostrander #1593, was working uniformed patrol Car 10 with my partner for the day Officer Shaffer #1673. We were on Vernon Odom Blvd. when we heard uniformed patrol Car 20 call out shots fired behind their cruiser on East Ave, near Vernon Odom Blvd. I drove to where Car 20 called the initial shots fired call when I observed Officer Fields #1506 and Officer Stewart-Loar #1650 running southbound on the east side of East Ave. near Miller South High School.

I drove our cruiser parallel to the officers running southbound when I observed an unknown suspect, later identified as Jazmir Tucker, standing in the grass in front of Miller South High School. I heard Officer Fields yell commands towards the suspect to not move then observed Tucker begin to run southbound. I continued to parallel Tucker in the furthest most right lane of East Ave. when I attempted to advance further to get out of the cruiser online with the other officers. While getting on-line I heard two shots fired, and I immediately turned the cruiser around. I exited the vehicle with Officer Shaffer, and we both proceeded to get online with the other officers aiming our firearms at Tucker, now laying on the ground. I shouted commands for Tucker to get his arms out to the side, but Tucker was unresponsive.

We waited for other officers to arrive on scene, then moved the line back behind multiple cruisers for cover. Once two shields were online, we advanced towards Tucker. Once next to Tucker, I grabbed his right hand and placed it behind his back while Officer Shaffer grabbed his left hand. We put Tucker in handcuffs then searched his pockets for weapons when we found a loaded 9mm pistol, with an extended mag, in his right outermost coat pocket. We secured the firearm then used trauma shears to get his clothing off to provide first aid. I attempted to put a chest seal on his gunshot wound, but the chest seal stuck to my glove causing me to be unable to put it on. Akron Paramedics arrived on scene and took over medical aid.

I began to look for shell casings, but was sequestered to be questioned about the events that took place.

Additional documents included a crime scene log consisting of 4 pages and a "Field Case Report" consisting of 3 pages.

A "Report of Investigation" authored by Lieutenant Whitmire #1419 provided an overview of the information known about the incident as well as attempts to view surveillance video from a camera located on 1074 East Avenue.

I, Ofc. J. Bishop #1507, was assigned to Car #2 on Plt. 3 along with Ofc. T. Hoar #1632 on 11/28/2024. We responded to the area of 1077 East Ave. upon hearing Car #20 call out signal 21 over the radio. As we arrived, I parked our marked patrol cruiser at the intersection of Vernon Odom Blvd. and East Ave. in order to prevent any southbound traffic from coming into the area. Myself and Ofc. Hoar approached the scene on foot as the officers nearest the scene were approaching the suspect. I provided security around the inner perimeter until the suspect was secured. Once the suspect was secured, I assisted Ofc. Fields #1506 away from the scene. I did not speak with Ofc. Fields about the incident and just made sure he was not injured. I then assisted other officers in setting up crime scene tape in the northern area of the scene. Myself and Ofc. Hoar were then tasked with providing security to Cruiser #20, which was parked in the rear parking lot of 670 Vernon Odom Blvd. After the area was processed by BCI, I followed in Car #2 as Ofc. Hoar drove Car #20 to the Morely parking deck. Upon returning Car #20 to Ofc. Fields, myself and Ofc. Hoar departed in Car #2 to respond to calls for service.

REFERRED TO PROS

On November 28th, 2024 while working uniform patrol car #18 Officer #1667 and I, Officer #1552, heard Car #20 call out with shots fired near the intersection of Vernon Odom Blvd and East Ave and notified dispatch of signal 5 radio traffic. Soon after Car #20 called out with a signal 21. My partner and I arrived on scene at 1055 East Ave where I observed multiple officers giving verbal commands to the suspect, Jazmir Tucker. One of the officers asked us to check the north parking lot and stated that was where the shots had originated from. Myself, Officer #1667, Officers #1589, and Officer #1587 cleared the parking lots to the north and east side of the above address. Once the parking lots were clear I made my way back to the suspect's location. I observed a pistol laying next to the suspect, who was receiving aid from EMS. I then assisted other officers and canvassed the area. Two pistol shell casings were located in the northeastern portion of the parking lot where the shots fired were reported coming from. I then maintained scene security for the remainder of the call.

I, Ofc. Carmany #1492, and Ofc. Simmons #1645 were assigned to Car 3 on 11/28/24. When we heard Car 20 say over dispatch "Signal 5" and "Shots Fired" we began to respond to their location. Once on scene we blocked the intersection of East Ave and Vernon Odom Blvd with our cruiser. We then exited our cruiser and observed officers approaching the suspect and begin rendering aid to him. I then instructed officers to begin putting up crime scene tape around the scene. Officer Simmons and I then located eight rifle casings on the side walk and grass along East Ave about 40 feet from where the suspect was down. We put folded paper markers down to mark where the casings were for when BCI responded to the scene. While Ofc. Simmons stood by the casings I began to canvas the nearby homes and apartment buildings. 706 Stevenson Pointe had a Ring camera on the front the door, but the residents inside stated to me that it had not recorded anything since 2150hrs. 708 and 710 Stevenson Pointe did not have any cameras and the residents stated they did not witness anything that took place. 1074 East Ave. had a camera on the front of the home, but there was no answer at the door, there was also no prior calls linked to the address and the car in the driveway (GNF8047) did not come back with a registered owner when ran on LEADS. Officers Simmons and I continued to stand by the casings we located and also guarded the suspect's gun and belongings that were laying in the grass where he fell to the ground. We then were relieved of our duties once BCI responded to the scene.

On 11/28/24 I, Ofc.Coblentz 1586 was working Car 12. I was in the area of Copley Rd. & Edgewood when I heard multiple shots fired near the area of Vernon Odom & East Ave. Upon hearing the shots I heard Car 20 call out on the radio reference Shots Fired followed by Signal 5 Emergency Traffic. I immediately headed southbound on Edgewood towards Vernon Odom Blvd. Car 20 then called out reference a Signal 9 male on foot from the area of the shots fired.

When I arrived at the intersection of Edgewood & Vernon Odom Blvd. I heard Car 20 call out Signal 21 Emergency Traffic. We stood by in the Emergency Department until relieved by detectives and a car from midnights so we could take calls and clear up the board.

I, Officer Miller 1491, was assigned to atrol Car 4 on 11/28/2024. Around 2300 hrs I was at George Washington Blvd./224 E (East Waterloo Rd.) when I heard the officers in patrol Car 20 call out they heard shots fired near East Ave./Vernon Odom Blvd. I was pulling into the Get Go gas station on 224 E. when I heard the officers over the radio say "shots fired". Around 2301 hrs, a Signal 21 was dispatched. I immediately activated my overhead lights and sirens and began towards patrol Car 20. Around 2309hrs I arrived on scene. I began assessing the need for scene security. I observed crime scene tape was being displayed, EMS was on scene, and there were no crowds or traffic. I started to walk towards the group of officers who were assisting EMS to see if an officer was needed to follow EMS to the hospital. As I was walking towards them, Sgt. Woodin was requesting shift representatives for the two officers assigned to patrol Car 20. I responded I was a shift rep and began headed back towards the cruisers near the intersection of East Ave./Vernon Odom Blvd. where I last saw both officers from patrol Car 20. Once I located one of the officers, I walked him over to grab his water from patrol Car 20 and we sat in patrol Car 19. I advised this officer not to speak with anyone about the incident, not even me, until he was advised further by a union rep. I stayed with him until he was dismissed from the scene by his shift commanders. After dropping him off at the Morley Deck, I went back into service.

On 11/28/2024, Officer Wood 1591 and I, Officer Phillips were assigned to uniformed patrol in Car 8. At approximately 2301 hours, we heard Car 20 over the radio request a signal 5 traffic due to shots fired in the area of East Ave. and V. Odom Blvd. We heard Car 20 mention a signal 9 a few seconds later with a statement of additional shots fired.

At this time, Officer Wood and I were traveling Southbound on East Ave. and arrived at Miller South School at 1077 East Ave. On scene we observed officers standing on the grass, directly in front of the school. The officers were facing the building, eastbound, standing shoulder to shoulder with their firearms pointing eastbound. Due to the darkness we were unable to determine what officers were on scene and who was standing where. Once online with those officers, we observed Jazmir Tucker, lying face down in the grass. His head was pointing south, and his feet were pointing toward the north. Officers began to give loud, direct commands to show his hands, however, there was no response.

As additional officers arrived on scene, a tactical plan was formulated to approach the suspect. We then observed Officer Shaffer and Officer Ostrander secure the suspect Tucker, in handcuffs and began to render aid. At one point I observed a black handgun, with an extended magazine that had blue tape on it. The handgun was laying on the ground to the west of Tucker. At this time AFD arrived on scene and took over. Tucker was transported from the scene to the hospital by AFD. Following this, we preceded to walk northbound through the parking lot and yard until we found Car 20 parked in the parking lot in the rear of the Antioch Baptist Church, 670 Vernon Odom Blvd. We did not locate any evidence during the canvas of the areas.

Shortly after we walked eastbound through the parking lot and Southbound through the behind Miller South School. We preceded to walk all the way around the building, at which time we did not locate any evidence. At this point, we cleared the scene and proceeded to answer calls for service throughout the city.

On 11/28/2024 at approximately 23:01 hours I, Sergeant Farr #1452, was working Car 46. I was at the police station on the 5<sup>th</sup> floor when I heard Officer Fields #1506, who was working Car 20, call out that they heard shots fired near their location at East Av/Vernon Odom Blvd. Moments later, Officer Fields called out on the radio that shots were fired, one suspect was down and asked for "Signal 5" traffic, which is Emergency Radio Traffic Only. He then stated this was a "Signal 21" which is an Officer Needs Emergency Assistance.

Sgt Woodin #1392, Lt Murphy#1283 and I left from the 5<sup>th</sup> floor and responded to the scene. On the way to the scene I heard several officers asking for another shield, which I knew I had in the back of my marked patrol unit. Once on scene I grabbed my shield to assist. Several other officers and I made the initial approach to the suspect, later identified as Jazmir Tucker, who was lying in the grass on the south side of the school, Miller South, located at 1055 East Av.

Officers applied handcuffs and searched Jazmir for weapons, at which time they located a pistol in his jacket pocket that had an extended magazine on it. I instructed officers to place the firearm on the ground and assigned an officer to remain with it. Once Jazmir was searched, I instructed officers to take off his jackets to locate any possible injuries. I instructed officers to apply a chest seal to a wound located on his lower left chest/stomach area.

AFD arrived on scene and I instructed officers to take Jazmir out of handcuffs so they could assess and treat Jazmir. During this time I assisted in canvassing the immediate area to locate any evidence, which I had negative results. I remained on scene and supervised officers for the duration of the call. I held inner scene security for BCI, and served as a liaison for Lt Murphy and Captain Miles #1288. Car 10, Officer Fields (#1506) and Officer Loar (#1650) advised to dispatch that they heard multiple shots fired in the area of East Ave. and Vernon Odom Blvd. Shortly after this, Officer Fields advised that he was out with a suspicious person near the parking lot of Miller South School (1055 East Ave.) At that time, I started to drive towards the area of 1055 East Ave. to assist as a backup unit. While I was en route, Officer Fields advised dispatch that there were shots fired and there was a signal 21 (Officer needs help). I immediately activated my overhead lights and sirens and continued to the officers needing assistance.

While en route, officers that had arrived on scene at 1055 East Ave., advised of several intersections that needed to be blocked off and that they needed a shield. I advised those units that I had a shield and that I was en route. When I arrived on scene, I observed several units standing in row to the west of Miller South. I exited my cruiser and secured the shield that was located in the rear of marked cruiser #44. As I made my way towards the scene, I made contact with Officer Wood, who advised that there were shots fired. Officer Wood also advised that there was one subject (later identified as Jazmir Tucker) down and that he was not complying to the verbal commands that the officers were issuing. As I got closer to the scene, I observed Jazmire laying down on his stomach, to the south of where the officers were standing.

There was also a request for a second shield, to which Sgt. Woodin was en route with. While we were waiting for the second shield, I had the units on scene move to cover. While we were behind cover, I made sure that we had lethal coverage, another person to hold the second shield for cover, and a hands team. As soon as the second shield arrived, we got into place and approached the Jazmir. As we approached Jazmir, I observed a phone near his head. I was unable to observe where the subject had sustained injuries, but he did appear to be unconscious. Once we got close enough to Jazmir, the two officers who were designated as the hands team placed him in handcuffs. Officer then immediately began to

administer first aid. Once the officers started to administer aide, I asked Officer Fields if "he shot", to which he advised he did. At that time, I took Officer Fields and his partner, Officer Loar away from the scene and sequestered them in separate cruisers. I made sure that there was an officer that was with them at all times. I observed EMS arrive and start to administer first aide to Jazmir. Jazmir was transported to AGMC for further treatment. I then made sure that the scene was properly secure with crime scene tape.

Once the scene was secured I, along with several other officers, searched the scene for possible shell casings. After I search the scene I continued to stand by while BCI arrived and began to conduct their investigation. At approximately 0200 hrs., I cleared the scene.

On November 28<sup>th</sup>, 2024, I, Sergeant Woodin #1392, was working Car 48. I was at the police station on the 5<sup>th</sup> floor when I heard Car 20 Officer Fields #1506 call Signal 5 (emergency radio traffic) and stated he heard shots fired in the area of V. Odom Blvd. and East Ave. Officer Fields called over the radio he would be out with a person reference the shots fired. Officer Fields called over the radio shots fired, suspect down, and stated Signal 21 (Officer Needs Emergency Assistance).

I left the 5<sup>th</sup> floor and responded to the scene. While enroute I got on services channel and requested they stage a Med Unit. When I arrived on scene, I took the shield out of the back of my cruiser and handed it off. There were enough officers to approach the suspect, so I started instructing other officers to set a perimeter and where I wanted it set. After the officers had the suspect in custody, I asked Officer Fields a few safety questions. Once those were answered I advised him and Officer Loar #1650 (Officer Fields partner in Car 20) to turn off and power down their BWC's. After they were powered off, I took possession of both of them. I walked Officer Fields and Officer Loar over to the Command Post area. I separated them into different cruisers with Union shift reps.

At this time I asked if any other officers were involved or witnesses the incident. Officer Ostrander #1593 and Officer Shaffer #1673 stated they were pulling up when it happened. Not knowing fully if they were witnesses, I advised them to turn off and power down their BWC's. After their BWC's were powered off, I took possession of them. Officer Ostander and Officer Shaffer were walked over to the Command Post area and separated with Union shift reps.

I was advised that 1074 East Ave. had cameras on the outside of the house but no one answered the door. I found two different phone numbers attached to the location and called both. I did not get an answer on either call.

The Crime Scene Unit responded to the Command Post and I turned over the BWC's to Detective Milewski.

Officer Ostrander #1593, and I, Officer Shaffer #1673 were patrolling District 10 in car 10. At 23:01 pm we heard signal 5 traffic come over the radio. At that time, we were traveling east on Vernon Odom Blvd. at East Ave. We realized from the radio traffic that the call was coming in from our location. We turn south on East Ave. and saw officers from car 20 chasing the suspect south through the grass in front of the school. We activated our lights and sirens, sped up and paralleled the chase in our cruiser. When we got up next to the school, I heard what sounded like three shots ring out. We turned the cruiser around and got out on foot. Once on foot we drew our duty pistols and got on line with the officers of car 20. The four of us gave commands to the suspect to put his arms out to his side, which he did not respond to. Other officers arrived and got on line with us until shields were available. Together we approached the unresponsive suspect whose hands were tucked underneath his body. I gloved up and went hands on with officer Ostrander to affect the arrest. During the search of the suspect, I found a loaded handgun with an extended magazine, in his front right jacket pocket. Officer Ostrander, and I then removed the suspect's jacket and shirt revealing a gunshot wound to the chest. At that time, we rendered first aid by applying a chest seal to the wound. AFD then arrived, at that point I took off the handcuffs so AFD could render aid to the suspect. Then the suspect was taken by AFD to AGMC. Finally, I was sequestered and bodycam taken by a supervisor.

## **ACTION TAKEN:**

Shortly after, I began a crime scene log and maintained scene security for the remainder of the call.

After the bystanders went away, I returned to Car #16 at East Ave./Manchester Rd. for the remainder of the call directing traffic and getting individuals to and from their residence.

Once on scene at Akron General Hospital, The Unknown male was taken into treatment and shortly after was pronounced deceased by medical staff at 11:29 p.m. We stayed at the hospital and attempted to identify the unknown suspect until medical examiner arrived. We were unable to identify the male at this time. The medical examiner and BCI agent arrived on scene to conduct their investigation. The unknown male's body was taken into the medical examiner's custody.

Officer Butler 1671, and I, Officer Williams, were assigned to car 14 in district 4. We were at the intersection of E Market St and N Prospect St. We heard car 20 call signal 5 and shots fired. I heard Officer Fields out of the cruiser running. We stared to towards the intersection of East Ave and Vernon Odom Blvd. We heard Officer Fields dispatch shots fired suspect is down.

Officer Butler and I arrived on scene and got on line with other officers. We were waiting one more shield to approach the suspect safely. Once the additional shield was on scene officers approach. We placed the suspect under arrest in handcuffs. Officers recovered a loaded pistol with an extended magazine out of the suspect right front pocket. Once AFD was on scene officers took suspect Jazmir Tucker out of handcuffs so AFD can render aid. AFD rushed Tucker to Akron general.

I along with other officers canvased the area for the shell casing from the first shots fired. Officers were able to locate two shell casing on the north east side of the incident location.

On 11/28/2024, Officer G. Phillips 1652 and I, Officer R. Wood 1591, were assigned to uniformed patrol Car 8. At approximately 2301 hours, we heard Car 20 over the air request signal 5 traffic due to shots fired in the area of East Avenue and Vernon Odom Boulevard. Within seconds, we heard Car 20 mention a Signal 9, followed by a statement of additional shots fired.

At this time, Ofc. G. Phillips and I were traveling southbound on East Avenue and began to arrive on scene at Miller South School, 1055 East Avenue. On scene, we observed several officers standing in the grass, directly in front of the school. The officers were facing eastbound, standing shoulder to shoulder, with their firearms pointing eastbound.

Due to the darkness and approaching the officers from the rear, we were unable to determine what officers were on scene and who was standing where. Once on line with those officers, we observed the suspect, Jazmir Tucker, lying face down in the grass. His head was pointing towards the south and his feet were pointing towards the north. Officers began to give loud verbal commands at Tucker to show us his hands, however, there was no response.

As additional officers arrived on scene, a tactical plan was formulated to approach the suspect. On approach, we observed Ofc. Shaffer and Ofc. Ostrander secure Tucker in handcuffs and begin to render aid. At one point, I observed a black handgun with an extended magazine laying to the west of tucker. At this time, AFD arrived on scene and took over. Tucker was subsequently transported from the scene to the hospital via AFD.

Following this, we proceeded to walk northbound from where Tucker was lying to canvass for any evidence. We walked northbound through the yard and parking lot, until we reached Car 20 parked in the rear of Antioch Baptist Church, 670 Vernon Odom Boulevard. We did not locate any evidence during this canvass.

Shortly after, we walked eastbound through the parking lot and southbound behind Miller South School. We proceeded to walk all the way around the building, at which time we did not locate any evidence. At this point, we cleared the scene and proceeded to answer calls for service throughout the city.



Upon arrival I spoke with Capt. Beitzel (1068) who briefed me on the incident.

Officers Fields and Loar were sitting in their patrol car behind the Antioch Babtist Church, 670 Vernon Odom Blvd. While behind the church, they heard gunshots that came from their southwest. They got out on foot to investigate. While investigating, they came across a male, who fled from them on foot in front of Miller South. Officer Fields used force against the male to affect his arrest. The male, who remained unidentified, later died at Cleveland Clinic Akron General (CCAG).

Sgt. Farr (1452) briefly walked me through the scene. I observed Officer Fields and Loar's cruiser parked behind 670 Vernon Odom Blvd. In front of Miller South, approximately 25 yards past the front driveway entrance, I observed spent 5.56/.223 shell casings. Sgt. Farr walked me down into a parking lot of Miller South, northeast of the school near the dumpsters, where two spent 9mm casings were located.

I was informed that Miller South did not have any external surveillance cameras. There was an external surveillance camera on 1074 East Av, directly across the street was where the use of force occurred. Responding officers knocked on the door but were unable to contact any residents.

I met with Special Agent Jon Lieber who would be handling the use of force investigation on behalf of BCI. I informed him of what I knew at that point.

At the station I reviewed the body worn camera (BWC) of Ofc. Fields and Ofc. Loar.

Later, while reviewing Ofc. Shaffer's BWC, you can see an officer remove a loaded firearm from the suspect's pocket.

The firearm was later collected by BCI and found to be a 9mm Taurus G2C (AEB092621).

I contacted the Summit County Medical Examiner's Office. At that point, they still had been unable to identify the suspect.

On November 29, 2024, Det. Sutton (1076) called me. He informed me that Jazmir Tucker's family had called him, questioning if Tucker could be the unidentified suspect. Det. Sutton was familiar with Tucker and later identified him.

Det. Sutton and I later made the notification of Tucker's passing to his mother, Ashley Green, while accompanied by an advocate from the Victim Assistance Program.

On December 3, 2024, I looked up prior calls at 1074 East Av. A surveillance camera was located on the front of the home, directly across from the use of force incident at 1055 East Av. I was able to identify Israel Turner as a prior caller from the address.

I called Turner who denied living at 1074 East Av. any longer, but gave me two numbers of who would have control of the camera. The numbers he provided were

I called and spoke with a woman, presumably Bonnie Groves. Groves informed me that her mother lived at 1074 East Av., and she was aware that BCI had left a door hanger asking to be called. Groves said that the camera we noticed was functional but only captured her mother's driveway, not the front of the school. She had looked at the footage previously and said the only thing it captured around the time of the incident was police lights in the area.

I asked if I could meet with Groves to view the camera angles myself and she said she could send me what she had. I provided her with my city cell phone number, and she agreed to text me. Despite this, she never texted me the angles.

On December 4, 2024, I was notified that the firearm recovered from Tucker NIBIN hit to two other Akron Police Department incidents, reference reports, 23-136790 and 24-140334.

23-136790 occurred on November 28, 2023 near Bisson Av./Belleflower Rd. During the incident, Alexander Parson and Jordan Parson were involved in a shootout with three unknown males. Both Parsons were later charged with Discharging Over a Roadway. The three unknown suspects that shot at the Parsons were never identified.

I reviewed the surveillance footage that captured the three unknown males that were involved. They all appeared to be younger teenagers, but they were all completely covered, including wearing masks, making identifying them nearly impossible.

24-140334 stemmed from an incident at 1877 12th St. SW on November 24, 2024.

The case remains under investigation and at the time of this report.

On December 9, 2024, I was notified that the gun found on Tucker NIBIN hit to the spent 9mm shell casings found near Miller South. This is the same location that officers heard the initial gunshots come from that caused them to investigate the incident.
