On November 12, 2024, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Nick Valente (Valente) completed a review of the video captured from the body-worn camera (BWC) of Officer Tario Humphries (Officer Humphries) during this incident.

Amped Replay was used to review the video.

SA Valente made a working copy of the BWC video and placed the copied video in a folder on his BCI issued laptop. The working copy of the video was used for the review.

The view of the camera appeared to be blocked by Officer Humphries hand or arm. The recording captured audio of a conversation between what sounded like the voices of Detective Robinson, Detective Laurello, and unknown parties who stated they were family of the subject. The subject's family briefly inquired about the investigation and the conversation ended. No derivative works were made from this recording.
