TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES—USE OF FUNDS RECEIVED FROM GASOLINE TAX—SIDEWALKS MAY NOT BE CONSTRUCTED FROM SUCH FUNDS.

SYLLABUS:

A board of township trustees may not lawfully use the township's portion of the proceeds of the gasoline excise tax fund provided by Section 5541-8 of the General Code, to construct sidewalks within the road casement but outside of the portion of the road traveled by motor vehicles.
