On May 30, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Chad Holcomb was assigned to assist the Marysville Police Department (MPD) with an officer involved critical incident. It was reported that a male, Matthew Todhunter (Todhunter), was pointing a gun at people while standing in the street. Union County Sheriff's Deputy Jacob Matejko arrived on scene and later discharged his weapon striking Todhunter. Todhunter was transported to the hospital where he was later pronounced deceased. His body was transported to the Montgomery County Coroner's Office for an autopsy.

On May 31, 2022, BCI SA Doug Eveslage attended the autopsy of Todhunter (see report by SA Eveslage). At the conclusion of the autopsy, SA Evelsage took custody of all items collected. At 1021 hours, SA Holcomb took custody of all items from SA Eveslage. The following items were packaged and labeled:

Item #	Description
#1	Two projectiles
#2	Oral and rectal swabs, fingerprints, fingernail
	scrapings, head and pubic hair
#3	DNA card for Todhunter
#4	Gauge earring
#5	White sock

At 1102 hours, SA Holcomb submitted item #1 to the BCI laboratory for examination.

At 1116 hours, SA Holcomb placed items #2-5 in the BCI temporary evidence locker to be placed in the BCI major crimes evidence vault.
