Narrative:

On Friday, January 16, 2026, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Allison Fletcher (SA Fletcher) received documents from Euclid Police Department (EPD) Detective Sergeant Nick Edington (Edington). The records which were requested included any reports pertaining to the January 11, 2026, officer-involved critical incident, except for any statements made by the involved officers. The document has been attached to this report for further review.

SA Jesse Bynum (Bynum) reviewed the documents and noted the following:

The report was 27 pages and included narratives completed by the following Euclid PD officers:

- Officer Timothy Ramos (#65)
- Officer Allan Garbaloff (#18)
- Detective George Harper (#23)
- Officer Kassie Mason (#47)
- Sergeant Nate Reed (#103)
- Captain D. Holden (#391)
- Detective David Carpenter (#02)

In reviewing the report, SA Bynum learned the following:

Officer Timothy Ramos (Ramos) was on scene at the time of the shooting incident. He authored the incident report for EPD with an incident number [REDACTED]. The report was titled "DV/ OIS" and dated January 11, 2026, 23:00:00. Officer Ramos was the officer who spoke with [REDACTED] and provided quotes of what she said prior to the incident. Officer Ramos wrote that officers responded to a domestic violence call involving [REDACTED] and Robert Riddlebarger (Riddlebarger). Punckowski stated she was waiting at a neighbor's home after the purported domestic violence.

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Officer Ramos stated that Punckowski advised that her daughter was in the house and that Riddlebarger was armed with a rifle.

██████████ was reported saying:

"I'm here! My babies at 1451, please!" "He started beating the shit outta me. He's trying to kill me!" "He's my baby daddy".

I asked if he (Robert) had any guns? She replied "Yes".

Officer Ramos also detailed the commands issued by Officer Wolk as the following:

1st warning (22:32:21) "Occupant of 1851, come to the front door with your hands empty."
2nd warning "Occupant of 1851 E 219 St, come to the front door, slowly open it with your hands empty.
3rd warning "Occupant of 1851 E 219, this is the Euclid Police, open the door with your hands empty".
4th warning "Occupant of 1851, this is the Euclid Police, open the door with your hands empty."

After being corrected;

5th warning (22:33:21), 1st with the correct address. "Occupant of 1451 E 219 St, come to the front door with your hands empty. This is the Euclid Police."
6th and final warning. "Occupant of 1451 E 219 St, this is the Euclid Police, final warning, come to the front door with your hands empty now."

Officer Ramos was outside when he heard gunshots. Officer Ramos stated that he observed a muzzle flash and more shots and ran in to assist officers. Officer Ramos located and removed the female child from the residence.

Officer Allan Garbaloff (Officer Garbaloff) was on scene at the time of the shooting incident. He authored a supplement in the EPD Investigative Report titled "SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT" dated January 12, 2026, 01:41:39. Officer Garbaloff was near the rear of the residence and could observe the interior and Riddlebarger. Officer Garbaloff described his view of the incident as the following:

As verbal commands started over the patrol car loudspeaker, I observed Riddlebarger walk up to the front door and look outside the door. I put this observation on the radio to alert officers located at the front of the residence. I then observed Riddlebarger walk away from the door and come back with what looked like a longer barrel-style rifle to look outside the front door again. This was also put over the radio to alert officers. At this time, Riddlebarger turned around and walked near the kitchen, which is when I gained confirmation that Riddlebarger was holding an AR-15 style rifle. This was also put over the radio. Riddlebarger then exited my view and did not return until the officers at the side door were about to make entry into the home.

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Detective George Harper (Det. Harper) was not present during the incident, but authored a report titled "DETECTIVE SUPPLEMENT" dated January 12, 2026, 02:45:49. Det. Harper stated in his report that he took photos of Riddlebarger at the hospital and collected his clothing.

Officer Kassie Mason (Officer Mason) was not present during the incident, but authored a report titled "SUPPLEMENT" dated January 12, 2026, 03:18:10. Officer Mason stated in her report that she assisted at the hospital.

Sergeant Nate Reed (Sgt. Reed) was not present during the incident, but authored a report titled "SUPPLEMENT" dated January 12, 2026, 03:53:14. Sgt. Reed stated in his report a basic summary of the incident.

Captain D. Holden (Capt. Holden) was not present during the incident, but authored a report titled "SUPPLEMENT" dated January 12, 2026, 14:14:49. Capt. Holden stated in the report that they assisted Officer Mason at the hospital. Capt. Holden also provided the names and phone numbers of the neighbors (Orysia Lee-Semko and Olga Lee) that allowed Punckowski to wait in their residence (3426 Norris Ave.) while on 911.

Detective David Carpenter (Det. Carpenter) was not present during the incident, but authored a report titled "SUPPLEMENT" dated January 13, 2026, 14:08:10. Det. Carpenter stated that he interviewed Dawn Riddlebarger the mother of Robert Riddlebarger on January 12, 2026.

Officers responded to the 1400 block of E 219 St. for a dispatched domestic violence. The reporting female called from a 911-only phone, reporting that she had been violently beaten by her child's father. She had fled the home and was waiting at a neighbor's house. Upon arrival, the police met the female who bore obvious facial injuries. She frantically pleaded with police, asking us to go to the house and save her daughter, who she believed was also in danger. The female advised that her child's father was very drunk, that he tried to kill her, and that he had firearms in the home.

Police immediately went to the residence to retrieve the child. Officers surrounded the house. They made several announcements via loudspeaker for the male to come to the front door with empty hands. The male responded by arming himself with a rifle visible to officers outside. Fearing the child was in imminent danger, officers breached the side door of the house while announcing themselves

as police. Seconds after entering, police encountered the male, armed with a rifle held at the ready. The officer who was confronted fired several rounds in self-defense, stopping the lethal threat. Officers simultaneously secured the male and began to render aid. The home was searched for the child, who was found in her bedroom. The male was almost immediately tended to by on-scene Euclid Fire Medics, who then transported him to the nearest trauma center. He did not survive and was pronounced deceased shortly after arrival.

The female victim and her daughter were transported together to Euclid Hospital, where both were checked and treated for injuries.

The Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation and The Euclid Police Department Detectives bureau took over investigation of the incident.

On January 11, 2026, at 2229 hours, ██████████ Kennerly #03, Garbaloff #18, Gorbey #61, Wolk #15, PO Aoki # 7, and I, PO Ramos #65, responded to 1451 E 219 St for a dispatched domestic violence incident. ██████████ reported her child's father, Robert Riddlebarger, had assaulted her and that she was hiding at a neighbor's house. While en route, Dispatch further advised that their daughter, ██████████ Riddlebarger, was still inside her parents' house, 1451 E 219 st, and that ██████████ was down the street at 1481, waiting for police. Dispatch advised that ██████████ told them she was "beaten half to death and bleeding". The 911 call was placed by a non-working cellphone.

Upon arrival, POs Garbaloff, Gorbey, and I made contact with ██████████ at 1481. She beckoned us to the front door, accompanied by the owner, Herschel Barnes. She was frantic and emotional. She pleaded for officers to go to her house and get ██████████ ██████████ Wolk, and Kennerly arrived and joined us at 1481. These officers stood just outside the doorway listening to ██████████ and me talk.

I asked ██████████ to go inside and speak with me. She did so with great hesitation, but stood close to the doorway. I confirmed with her that ██████████ and Robert were still in her home at 1451 E 219 St. I confirmed that she felt her daughter was in danger and that there were firearms present. ██████████ made the following statements, as confirmed by my body camera.

"I'm here! My babies at 1 4 5 1, please!" "He started beating the shit outta me. He's trying to kill me!" "He's my baby daddy".

I asked if he (Robert) had any guns? She replied " Yes".

██████████ repeatedly pleaded with verbal and physical motions for officers to go to her house. She was clearly distressed by our conversation. It was apparent she wanted us to go directly to the house. I attempted to calm her and ask more questions. I asked her why she felt her daughter was in danger. She replied, " Because he's drunk as shit and he started beating the crap out of me, I was bleeding everywhere, He is trying to kill me!"

To note, ██████████ is a fair-skinned white woman, about 501 tall and 140 lbs. Obvious injuries were visible on her face. Her nose was bloodied, and the right side of her face was red and bruised. She was in tears and not properly dressed for the cold weather (30°F, steady chilling breeze). She did not express concern for her own injuries, only the safety of her child.

I advised ██████████ to stay with Herschel and that officers were going to immediately get ██████████

Together, ██████████ Kennerly, Gorbey, Wolk, Garbaloff, and I advanced north, on foot, towards 1451. ██████████ alerted dispatch that a child inside was believed to be endangered and that firearms were present. I called for a medical squad to respond to ██████████ and for the next arriving police unit to respond to 1481. We then established a perimeter around the house. PO Wolk parked his marked police Unit, cruiser 15, in the front yard of 1461(the immediately adjacent house, just south of 1451) and prepared to issue loudspeaker commands.

It should be noted that CV Dispatch had, by this time, already made contact with Robert via telephone. They had asked him to come to the front door and speak to the police, but he responded with vulgar insults and

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sexual threats. CV Dispatch made him aware that the police were coming to talk with him. This information was put in the CAD for responding officers to see.

██████████ and Kennerly positioned themselves at the front door of the house (west wall). PO Wolk operated the loudspeaker of Unit 15. PO Garbaloff was positioned at the northwest corner of the detached garage in the rear of the house. I was positioned at the southeast corner of the home. PO Wolk began to make announcements on the loudspeaker. All officers were wearing full Euclid Police uniforms with badges and patches visible.

PO Wolk gave a total of 6 commands over the loudspeaker, starting at 22:32:21 hours. The first 4 were addressed erroneously as 1851 E 219. Multiple officers corrected him simultaneously, and he issued two more warnings with the correct address. The warnings went as follows.

1st warning (22:32:21) "Occupant of 1851, come to the front door with your hands empty."

2nd warning "Occupant of 1851 E 219 St, come to the front door, slowly open it with your hands empty."

3rd warning "Occupant of 1851 E 219, this is the Euclid Police, open the door with your hands empty".

4th warning "Occupant of 1851, this is the Euclid Police, open the door with your hands empty."

After being corrected;

5th warning (22:33:21), 1st with the correct address. "Occupant of 1451 E 219 St, come to the front door with your hands empty. This is the Euclid Police."

6th and final warning. "Occupant of 1451 E 219 St, this is the Euclid Police, final warning, come to the front door with your hands empty now."

All warnings were very loud and clearly heard from the back of the house. As soon as the warnings were issued, I heard movement coming from inside the house, consistent with a person walking back and forth through rooms. No movement was heard prior to the announcements. During the announcements, various officers could be heard discussing with each other the movement between rooms. PO Garbaloff, who had a clear view into the kitchen and part of the living room, periodically radioed that the male was armed with an AR-15 and updated his position as he travelled between the rooms. See his Supplement for further.

PO Aoki #07 arrived and joined the preparations for breaching.

██████████ Gorbey, Wolk, Kennerly, and Aoki repositioned to the side door (south-facing wall) in the driveway. They prepared for entry and breached using a Breaching RAM brought by PO Wolk. The breach was a single blow that dislodged the locked door completely. This occurred at 22:34:17. Those five officers then made entry with weapons drawn.

Upon entry, multiple officers screamed Police and other loud verbal commands, which I could hear from outside. I then heard multiple loud gunshots followed by commotion. I turned the corner back toward the side door and saw muzzle flash and more shots. I then ran to assist the officers.

The house was a bungalow style, with the side door entering into a small hallway between a basement door

and a kitchen. I announced my intention to enter the basement. I scanned, seeing no persons; however, an AR-15 style rifle lay on the ground at the bottom of the stairs. I peeked into the kitchen, seeing Robert on the ground, bleeding profusely, surrounded by loose 5.56 ammunition. Multiple officers were securing Robert in handcuffs and checking for further weapons. PO Garbaloff joined me, and we performed a protective sweep of the basement.

I then joined the other officers on the first floor to help perform a protective sweep of the first floor of the house. I yelled out, "Where is the baby"? [REDACTED] who had already searched for and located [REDACTED] replied, "Over here, back right. [REDACTED] was found in her crib wrapped in blankets. She was alert but frightened. PO Aoki stayed with her, checking her welfare and consoling her.

I then ran to exit the house as POs Wolk, Gorbey, and PO Mason #47 began to render aid. They called for a medic and advised that a male had gunshot wounds to the chest and that he came to the door with a rifle.

I ran outside to get a trauma bag. As I left, I encountered [REDACTED] walking towards the door. He told me, "I'm removing myself." I recognized he must have fired at least some or all of the shots. I then recognized that he may have been shot at or hit with fire. Although he was not obviously wounded, I have been trained to always check officers for injuries, as adrenaline may mask even grievous wounds. PO Garbaloff and I escorted [REDACTED] outside and checked him thoroughly for gunshot wounds. He had none. As I did this, I saw Euclid Fire personnel approaching on foot.

I advised Euclid Fire Department Medics to enter and render aid for a male with multiple gunshot wounds. I then went to speak with [REDACTED] who was running towards us. I informed her [REDACTED] was ok. I instructed her to wait for EMS at Herschel's house.

POs Blakemore #55 and Gerson #69 arrived on scene. PO Blakemore #55 remained with [REDACTED] and secured his Rifle. OIC Sgt Reed #103 arrived on scene and assumed command.

I then went to collect Arianna and bring her to [REDACTED] PO Aoki was consoling her, so we brought her outside, avoiding the kitchen. PO Aoki took care to cover her face with a blanket and soothe her as we left to mitigate trauma. It should be noted that the front door was blocked with several objects. It is unknown if this was done in an attempt to barricade the house. I moved the objects, and we took Arianna outside and to 1481. EFD then arrived to take [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] to Euclid Hospital.

While reuniting [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] advised that she had to make the 911 call with a "dead" phone and that she left without any other items. She advised that she had no family close by other than Robert's mother.

After convening with other officers to coordinate further actions, I secured the perimeter of the house with Police crime scene tape.

PO Garbaloff accompanied Robert with EFD Squad 1342 to the University Hospitals Main Campus. He succumbed to his wounds and was pronounced deceased shortly after arrival. The time of death was provided by Dr. Brian Young at 2305 hours. See PO Garbaloff's Supplement for further.

PO Mason accompanied [REDACTED] to Euclid Hospital. See her Supplement for Further. Cpt. Holden #391 also responded to Euclid Hospital, see her Supplement for further.

I spoke to Herschel at his home, confirming that [REDACTED] came to his home asking for help. She was already on the phone with dispatch. He agreed to be identified and cooperate with the police. He has a doorbell camera, which may hold evidence.

I spoke to Rita Finical, the resident directly south of 1451, at 1461 E 219 St. She stated she heard nothing until after EFD arrived to remove Robert from the home. She does not have any cameras.

No other houses in the area had exterior cameras. It appears from the lack of footprints that [REDACTED] did not approach any other neighbor's homes prior to contacting Herschel.

I waited on scene until Det Sgt Edington #179 and Det Mitchell #40 arrived on scene and relieved me. Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation officials were contacted and responded.

In summary, we responded to a domestic violence call involving a male who violently assaulted his child's mother. She was so scared that she fled the residence and hid at a nearby neighbor's home. Upon our arrival, the female complainant, clearly injured, expressed grave concern that her child, still inside the home, would also be harmed by her father. All officers on scene at that point understood that the suspect had access to firearms. Police surrounded the home and made multiple loudspeaker announcements, which clearly identified us as police, and demanded that the suspect surrender with nothing in his hands. Police saw through the windows that the suspect responded by arming himself with a rifle. Police forced entry and immediately encountered the suspect with a rifle held at the ready. Police fired several rounds in self-defense, stopping the lethal threat. They then simultaneously secured the suspect and rendered aid. Other officers searched for and found the child and removed her safely from the home. The female and her daughter were taken to an area hospital for treatment. The suspect was also taken to the closest trauma center for treatment; however, he succumbed to his wounds and was pronounced deceased. The scene was secured and then processed jointly by Euclid Police detectives and Ohio Bureau of Investigation investigators.

PO Aoki contacted the Cuyahoga County Department of Children and Family Services to report this incident and request services on behalf of [REDACTED]

I contacted Schaquilla at the Journey Center on behalf of [REDACTED] to report the domestic violence incident and request services.

I contacted Bill at the Children Who Witness Violence Hotline to report the incident and request services for [REDACTED]

A crime scene packet was completed to the fullest extent possible and then turned over to the detectives.

My body camera was activated and reviewed prior to writing the report.

On 01/11/2026, around 2232 hours, I responded to 1451 E 219th St for a report of a disturbance in progress involving a male and a female. The female caller, later identified as [REDACTED] stated to dispatch that her child's father, Riddlebarger, had physically assaulted [REDACTED] inside their home.

Upon arrival, I accompanied the officers to Jacqueline's residence, where she had previously stated her 3-year-old daughter, [REDACTED] Riddlebarger, was currently located [REDACTED] was at a neighbor's house, where she called the police, located at 1481 E 219th St. While there, [REDACTED] stated to officers that she believed that Riddlebarger would harm [REDACTED] and that she was in danger. As I made my way to 1451 E 219th, Ptl. Ramos and I coordinated to secure the backyard and gain a visual of the rear of the residence. Having the backyard secured and a clear line of sight of the rear of the residence, I waited for verbal commands to start. At this position, I had a clear line of sight through the residence to the interior of the front door.

As verbal commands started over the patrol car loudspeaker, I observed Riddlebarger walk up to the front door and look outside the door. I put this observation on the radio to alert officers located at the front of the residence. I then observed Riddlebarger walk away from the door and come back with what looked like a longer barrel-style rifle to look outside the front door again. This was also put over the radio to alert officers. At this time, Riddlebarger turned around and walked near the kitchen, which is when I gained confirmation that Riddlebarger was holding an AR-15 style rifle. This was also put over the radio. Riddlebarger then exited my view and did not return until the officers at the side door were about to make entry into the home.

I then heard the ram hit the side door and officers making entry into the residence. When I observed Riddlebarger the final time, he was positioned in the kitchen hallway with his AR-15 shouldered and at a low ready. Riddlebarger then raised his firearm and stabilized his balance, and got into an aggressive fighting stance. Simultaneously, I observed a firearm barrel from the opposite side of the window appear, indicating that officers were in the same room as Riddlebarger. Riddlebarger then made a furtive movement by pointing his AR-15 at officers. When I observed Riddlebarger make this movement, I heard approximately 9 or 10 shots that were fired by officers, causing Riddlebarger to fall out of my view. I immediately began running to the side door to enter and assist officers who were inside the residence.

When I entered the residence, Ptl. Ramos and I did a protective sweep of the basement of the residence to ensure that nobody else was in the basement. Ptl. Ramos and I then went upstairs and escorted [REDACTED] out of the house to be checked by EMS. While walking outside, I visually scanned [REDACTED] for any gunshot wounds or any other injuries. I did not observe any injuries to [REDACTED] and after he was handed off to EMS, I returned to the residence to assist further. I entered the residence and observed Riddlebarger's AR-15 on the ground, seemingly still loaded. I then put on gloves and safely picked the firearm up. At this time, I found that Riddlebarger's firearm's safety selector switch was set to semi and was ready to fire. I placed the selector to safe and attempted to unload the firearm. Due to the magazine being damaged by gunfire, I was unable to eject the magazine. I instead racked the charging handle multiple times to eject any remaining ammunition that would cycle, rendering the firearm safe. When racking the charging handle, the firearm ejected a total of 1 round from the chamber. I then placed the firearm selector switch on safe and put it back down on the kitchen floor.

EMS then retrieved Riddlebarger from the residence and carried him outside to the stretcher, and he was placed in the back of Medic 2. I then followed the squad to UH Main, where Riddlebarger was later pronounced deceased. I stayed at the hospital and awaited the Euclid Police Department Detectives' arrival.

The Detectives arrived at the hospital shortly after, and I was relieved of my duty at the hospital. I then went to EPD, where I docked my body-worn camera.

The entire interaction was recorded on my body camera, including some of Riddlebarger's movements prior to officers making entry into the home.

Nothing further to report.

On 1/12/26, I responded to the Cleveland Clinic Hospital, Euclid Emergency room to assist Officer Mason with care of the victim of a Domestic Violence incident. I met with [REDACTED] and her 3 YOA daughter, [REDACTED] Riddlebarger. [REDACTED] agreed to allow me interact with her daughter and be present while she was provided medical care.

Once [REDACTED] immediate medical concerns were addressed, nursing staff cared for [REDACTED] and allowed some privacy for us to discuss details of the officer interaction with Robert Riddlebarger, her child's father, at the residence. Officer Mason provided notification of Robert Riddlebarger's death due to gunshot injuries sustained on scene. [REDACTED] made utterances that she was in fear for her life when Robert was beating her. I observed [REDACTED] hair in a matted disaray with blood streaks in the back. She complained of pain on her left hand pinky finger, pain on her head, a severe headache, pain along her left hip and leg. [REDACTED] repeatedly stated that she believed Robert was trying to kill her earlier, had attempted to strangle her earlier in the night. Her complaints of pain and her broken nose were the result of being physically assaulted by her child's father, Robert Riddlebarger.

Additionally, BCI agent Thomas Verhiley met with [REDACTED] in an ER patient room. I remained present when Verhiley interviewed [REDACTED] briefly.

[REDACTED] was ultimately discharged from the ER with a diagnosis of a broken nose, and other contusions. She was directed to follow up with additional doctors. Although her left hand Pinky finger was swollen and bruised, the x-ray did not disclose a fracture.

Upon discharge, I transported [REDACTED] to Orysia Lee-Semko's house at 3426 Norris Ave. in Parma.

I met with Orysia Lee-Semko ("Echo") and Olga Lee who received [REDACTED] Both ladies provided me their phone numbers and were briefed with a summary of the incident.

[REDACTED] did not have a working phone in her possession. Both ladies provided the following phone numbers for contacting [REDACTED]

Orysia Lee- Semko ("Echo") [REDACTED]

Olga Lee [REDACTED]

My body camera battery had no charge. I utilized the body camera for 392 to document transport of [REDACTED] to her friend's residence.
