

**Narrative:**

On Monday, October 31, 2022, Ohio Bureau of Criminal Investigation (BCI) Special Agent (SA) Chuck Moran (Moran) received a “Firearms Trace Summary” report from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF). The report contained information about the firearm that Jeremy McCracken possessed and discharged during the incident on October 5, 2022.
